The Big Sin No One's Talking About

In these days of social media, instant communication, and the 24-hour news cycle, there's an age-old sin that's taken on new life. Almost no one talks about the harm it causes. Almost no one realizes how serious it can be. The sin is "detraction," and it deserves a closer look.

The Catechism tells us that detraction is a sin against the eighth commandment:

Respect for the reputation of persons forbids every attitude and word likely to cause them unjust injury. One becomes guilty of **rash judgment** who, even tacitly, assumes as true, without sufficient foundation, the moral fault of a neighbor; of **detraction** who, without objectively valid reason, discloses another's faults and failings to persons who did not know them; of **calumny** who, by remarks contrary to the truth, harms the reputation of others and gives occasion for false judgments concerning them. (CCC 2477)

Thus, detraction is one sin with three possible manifestations:

Rash Judgment: To assume, with no foundation, that you know the moral faults of another person.

Detraction: To share the moral faults of one person with another person who did not know those faults before, even if what you share is true.

Calumny: To tell a lie about the moral faults of another person.

The seriousness of detraction depends on from the gravity of the fault disclosed, on the dignity of the person attacked, and on the harm done to that person and to others by lowering his standing in the public eye. Detraction, therefore, can be very serious, depending on these three conditions. Like theft, detraction demands reparation. Often such reparation is impossible, because of the number of people informed or the complexity of the situation. In such cases, we are obliged to make what reparation we can, and to leave the rest to the power of prayer.

Ask yourself if you have been guilty of the sin of detraction. Have I deliberately harmed the good name of another? Have I entertained the dark joy of gossip at another person's expense? Do I realize that I can be guilty of detraction for defaming any person, even celebrities and politicians?

The word "holy" literally means "different." The Jewish people were called by God to be "holy," that is, "different," from all the other nations. Likewise, Jesus has called us to be a people who stand apart from the crowds, not only by our prayers, but by our actions and words. Before you repeat a story, whether in person or on the computer, take a moment to ask, "Is this rash judgment? Is this detraction? Is this calumny?"

Let's strive to make amends for the words we have spoken or written, to respect the dignity of each human person, and to remember that keeping silent when we do not need to speak is a great act of mercy. Let's be people who add to the well-being of others — not people who detract.

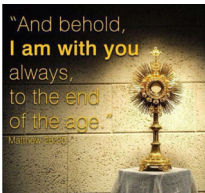

You may schedule your child for the Sacrament of Baptism (held all Sundays 1:30pm) by visiting the Parish website under Faith, Sacraments, Baptism. Date is confirmed once all paperwork is received in the office (at least 2 weeks prior to the date of desired Baptism.)

Matrimony

The priest must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.

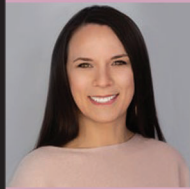

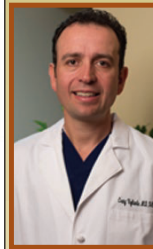
