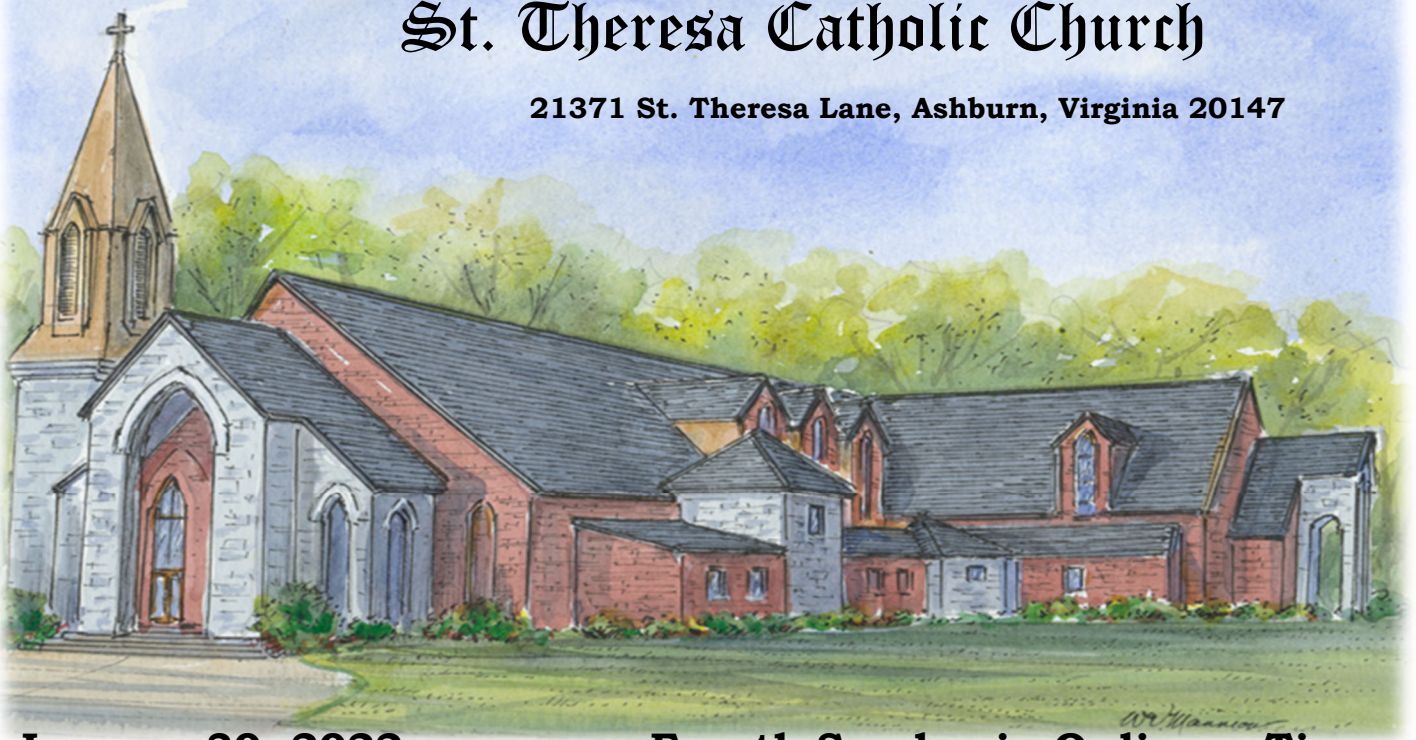

St. Theresa Celebrates Catholic Schools Week

The last Sunday in January kicks off an annual week-long celebration of Catholic education in the United States, known as National Catholic Schools Week. Catholic Schools Week is an opportunity to focus on the value Catholic education provides young people, as well as the contributions Catholic schools make to our parish, to our families, to our country, and to our entire Church.

I'm a product of Catholic education myself—from first grade through high-school. I'm deeply grateful for the opportunity I was given in those years. I'll never be able to calculate how great a spiritual advantage I was given when, for twelve years of my life, every day was imbued with prayer, the example hard-working, dedicated and sacrificial teachers, as well as the priceless witness of parish priests and religious sisters. The unheralded sacrifices of my mother, of my parish, and of my Diocese gave me a gift whose value I may never fully appreciate in this life. This week, I would ask you to think about that same gift that's offered right now to our students here at St. Theresa School, and to commit more deeply to supporting and strengthening your parish's efforts.

Catholic Schools Week is typically observed with Masses, devotions, open house events, as well as fun activities for teachers and students to help them appreciate that Catholic education is something very precious, and worthy of gratitude and celebration. This year, our theme is: **Faith. Excellence. Service.** Faith in Jesus Christ is the foundation of our school. Excellence in education, especially the formation of Christian virtues and the imitation of Christ, is our tangible goal. A commitment to serve others is one of its visible fruits.

You have every reason to be proud of your parish school. Our principal and our entire faculty are not merely employees doing a job, they are dedicated servants of a mission to share their knowledge in the context of their faith. I love how our principal Erin O'Malley once stated this: "St. Theresa is not a private school. We are a Catholic school. Our purpose for existence is to educate young Catholics in their faith. It is a secondary benefit that we can offer an exceptional academic program."

There's a joyful spirit about our halls. Our students and teachers don't just attend our school, they love our school. That's because so many people have sacrificed to make St. Theresa such a special place to learn. Let's ask for God to continue to bless our students and teachers as we celebrate Catholic Schools Week, together.

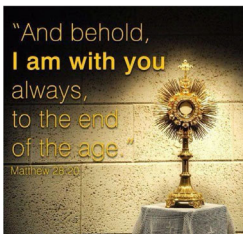

Sponsor Certificates

Please contact the Parish Office to obtain a sponsor certificate prior to a Baptism or Confirmation.

Baptisms

Parents desiring Baptism for their child must attend a class, preferably before the child's birth. The classes are held the first Thursday of each month at 7:30pm in the Louis Martin Conference Room in the Administration Bldg. After you attend the class, you may schedule your child for the Sacrament of Baptism (Sundays 1:30pm). Date is confirmed once all paperwork is received in the office. Forms can be found on the Parish website under Faith, Sacraments, Baptism.

Matrimony

The priest must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.

Visit the Parish Website under Faith, Sacraments, Marriage and fill out the Marriage Preparation Questionnaire prior to contacting the Parish Office. A priest will contact you.

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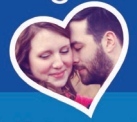

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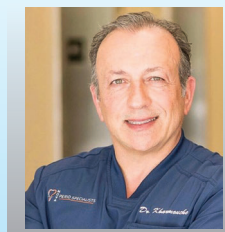
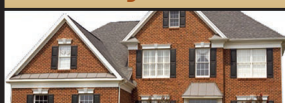
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
