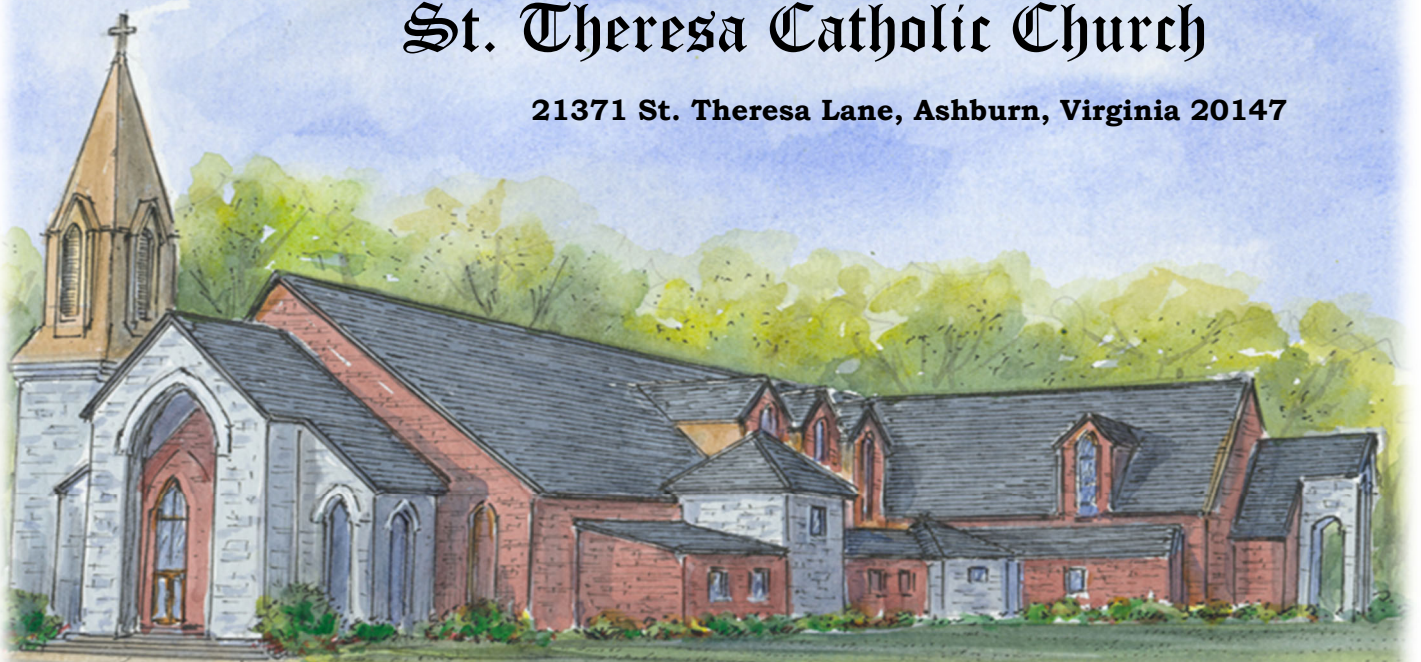

Understanding the Sacrament of Matrimony

In response to a question from one of our parishioners, let's take a closer look at the Sacrament of Matrimony. We will explore this topic in further detail in future weeks, since the subject matter is so vast.

Did you know that the man and woman themselves—and not the priest—are the celebrants of the Sacrament of Matrimony? To understand why, we must first understand Sacraments in general.

We believe that Jesus himself created seven Sacraments—Baptism, Eucharist, Penance, Confirmation, Holy Orders, Matrimony, and Anointing of the Sick. In each Sacrament, God's grace is given in a visible or tangible way. When does a baby receive the grace of Baptism? When the water is poured. When do we receive the grace of Christ in the Eucharist? When the host is consumed. When do we receive the grace of forgiveness of sins? When we hear the words, "I absolve you." In every Sacrament, invisible grace comes in a way that we can sense.

In every Sacrament, Jesus himself is the one who gives his grace, but he always works through an active and cooperating human being. In Baptism, Penance, Eucharist, and Anointing of the Sick, the priest actively chooses to let himself be Jesus' instrument. In Matrimony though, the priest plays a different role—he merely stands as a witness to the wedding in the place of Christ.

This witness of Christ is an essential part of Matrimony for every Catholic, regardless of whom they marry. In fact, this witness of Christ is so important that the Catholic Church does not recognize as valid the wedding of any Catholic who attempts to be married without it.

Who may stand in this role as Christ's witness to Matrimony? A bishop, priest, or deacon ordinarily do. With written permission from the bishop, obtained with the help of one's parish priest, another person may be delegated to be this witness—but this is the exception, not the norm. And let's not forget—this is a Church rule only, which applies to Catholics but not to the rest of the world. May non-Catholics marry one another without a priest? Of course they may. Does the Church recognize these weddings as valid? Of course they do.

However, many well-intentioned people simply do not know that Catholics should be married by a Catholic bishop, priest, or deacon. This holds true whether they marry a Catholic or a non-Catholic. If any parishioner has not been married in this way, kindly allow your parish priest to help. In many cases, all that is needed is the profession of one's vows with the priest as a witness.

Because Matrimony is a Sacrament that affects not only the couple but also the public, there must be at least two witnesses present as well—usually known as the "best man" and "maid of honor." These two requirements—the witness of Christ and of the public—are the two basics that must be part of every Catholic wedding. Next week, we will explore this topic a bit further.

Sponsor Certificates

After you attend the class, you may schedule your child for the Sacrament of Baptism (Sundays 1:30pm). Date is confirmed once all paperwork is received in the office. Forms can be found on the Parish website under Faith, Sacraments, Baptism.

Matrimony

The priest must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.

Visit the Parish Website under Faith, Sacraments, Marriage and fill out the Marriage Preparation Questionnaire prior to contacting the Parish Office. A priest will contact you.

RCIA

Adults desiring instruction in the Catholic Faith should visit the website to register for RCIA classes.

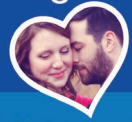
