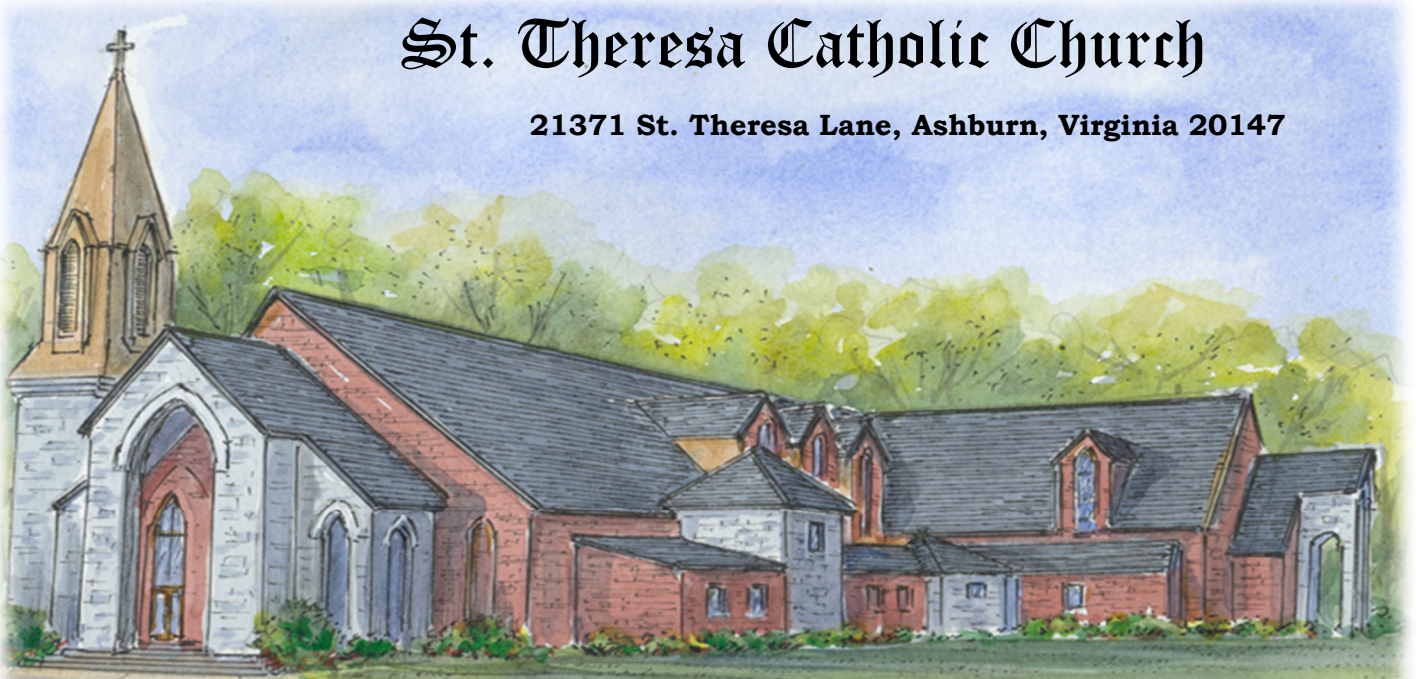

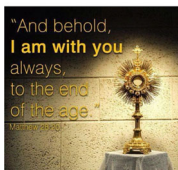

## Sacraments

### Sponsor Certificates

Please contact the Parish Office to obtain a sponsor certificate prior to a Baptism or Confirmation.

### Baptisms

Parents desiring Baptism for their child must attend a class, preferably before the child's birth. The classes are held the first Thursday of each month at 7:30pm in the Louis Martin Conference Room in the Administration Bldg. After you attend the class, you may schedule your child for the Sacrament of Baptism (Sundays 1:30pm). Date is confirmed once all paperwork is received in the office. Forms can be found on the Parish website under Faith, Sacraments, Baptism.

### Matrimony

The priest must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.

Visit the Parish Website under Faith, Sacraments, Marriage and fill out the Marriage Preparation Questionnaire prior to contacting the Parish Office. A priest will contact you.

### RCIA

Adults desiring instruction in the Catholic Faith should visit the website to register for RCIA classes.

### Hospitalized/Homebound

Please contact the Parish Office to ask for Holy Communion or the Anointing of the Sick.

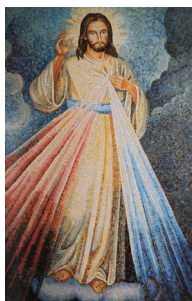

### Divine Mercy Mosaic for the Adoration Chapel

We have a special request. Normally we don't ask for this type of assistance but a parishioner reached out about having a Divine Mercy Image for the Adoration Chapel. We would like it to be a mosaic like we have at church. While we reach out to help others materially



through outreach, we also feel it's important to reach out spiritually and this would be a wonderful way, especially for those who visit the chapel who are soul searching. Jesus told St. Faustina, "By means of this image I shall grant many graces to souls." The image is a great reminder of Christ's love and mercy. There are many promises Jesus made in re-

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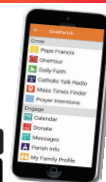
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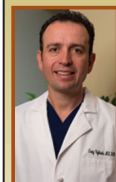
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
