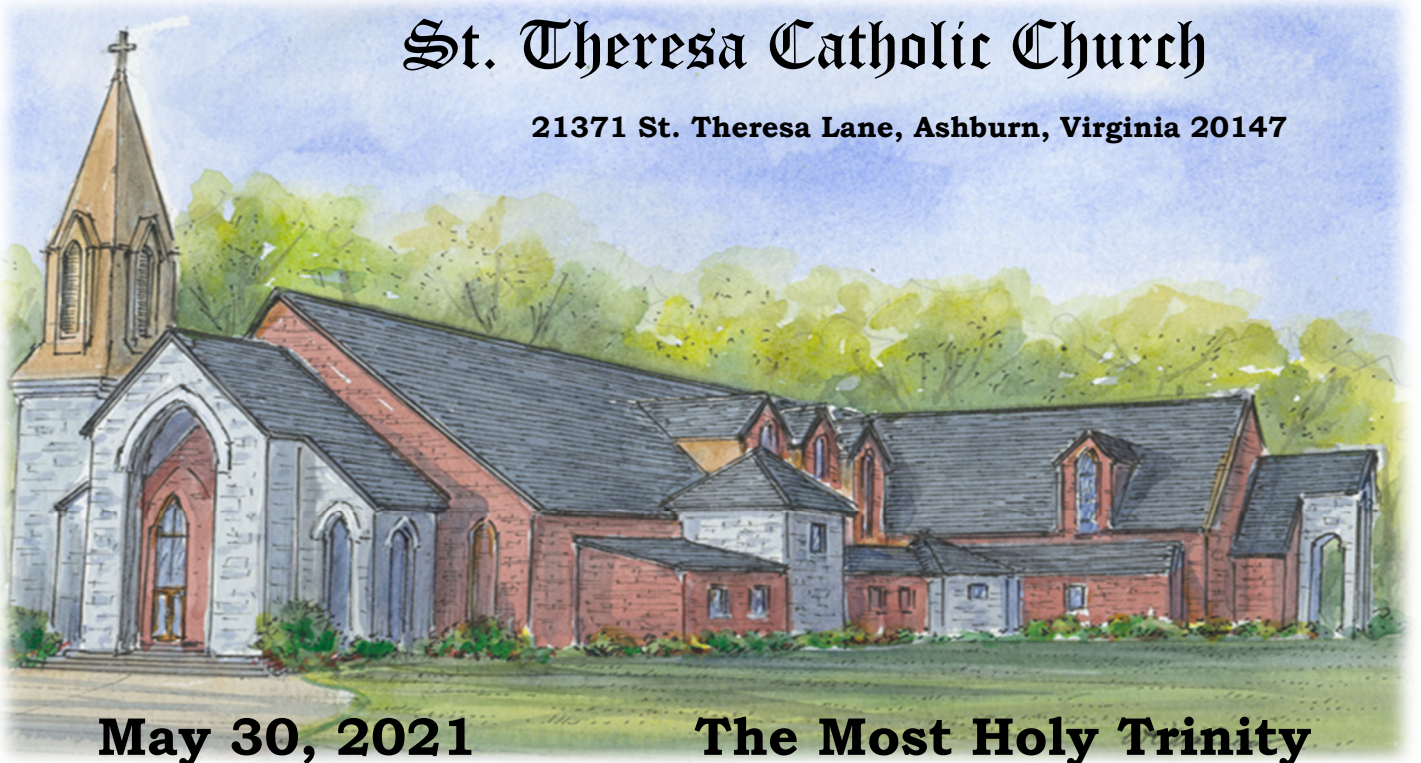

The Sacredness of Human Sexuality

In recent years, June has become known as “Pride Month,” with the intent of drawing attention to the phenomenon of homosexuality in society. While I don’t intend to address that topic *per se*, I believe this presents an important opportunity to reiterate our Church’s teaching on the meaning of human sexuality, designed by God to be good, true, and beautiful.

As Catholics, we believe sex is designed by God to be a sacred act, intended to be guarded and protected exclusively within the lifelong covenant of matrimony. Why is this the case? Because the act itself always has two natural, and inseparable consequences—an inexpressibly deep union between a man and a woman, together with the possibility of procreating new life. These two consequences go together by God’s design. First, the marriage act itself creates a deep, powerful, physical and spiritual bond which speaks a language all its own—a language that says, “I give myself entirely to you, and to you alone, for the rest of my life.” In fact, we believe sex is essentially sacramental—as marriage vows, physically expressed. It’s why the committed bond of marriage is the only context in which that sexual expression can be truthful. People often think the Church believes sex is sinful, but our belief is precisely the opposite. We believe sex is sacred.

The bond between the spouses is only one reason for this sacredness. The other reason is the possibility of procreating new life. Notice, I did not say “reproducing” new life, or “conceiving” new life, but rather “procreating” new life. Why the insistence on that term? Because at each moment of conception, something happens that changes the entire universe, forever. A human life, together with its immortal soul given only by God, is brought into existence in an event which is nothing less than a continuation of the divine act of creation, delegated to a husband and wife. This life, once conceived, needs the stability of the marriage covenant—the rock on which the family is built. Children need stable, committed mothers and fathers, and God intends to provide it, with our cooperation.

Although it’s deeply unpopular to state this, anyone who acknowledges this truth of human sexuality must also confess that to engage in sexual activity apart from marriage is to misuse the gift. It’s only because of the sacredness of sex that any sexual immorality, homosexual or otherwise, is seriously sinful. With regard to same-sex attraction, please remember: we believe that it is one temptation among many in a world that has forgotten the true meaning of this sacred act. All people suffer temptation, and all people deserve compassion and support in their struggle against it. The Catechism states it beautifully:

The number of men and women who have deep-seated homosexual tendencies is not negligible. This inclination, which is objectively disordered, constitutes for most of them a trial. They must be accepted with respect, compassion, and sensitivity. Every sign of unjust discrimination in their regard should be avoided. These persons are called to fulfill God’s will in their lives and, if they are Christians, to unite to the sacrifice of the Lord’s Cross the difficulties they may encounter from their condition. (CCC 2358-9)

I hope it’s clear that the Church’s teaching on same-sex attraction is the same teaching for any person struggling with temptations to unchastity. Christ calls all people to respect the sacredness of the sexual action, by recognizing its proper context, which is found only in marriage.

God bless you, and St. Theresa, pray for us!

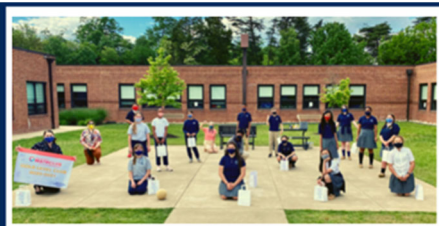

Sponsor Certificates

Please contact the Parish Office to obtain a sponsor certificate prior to a Baptism or Confirmation.

Baptisms

Parents desiring Baptism for their child must attend a class, preferably before the child's birth. The classes are held the first Thursday of each month at 7:30pm in the Louis Martin Conference Room in the Administration Bldg. After you attend the class, you may schedule your child for the Sacrament of Baptism (Sundays 1:30pm). Date is confirmed once all paperwork is received in the office. Forms can be found on the Parish website under Faith, Sacraments, Baptism.

Matrimony

The priest must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.
