The Mass in Slow Motion, Continued... The Responsorial Psalm

Let's continue taking a look at the Mass, as we have in past weeks. Today's focus is the most under-appreciated part of Mass—the Responsorial Psalm. If you came to Mass for the first time, you might find the Responsorial Psalm a bit odd. What is it? Is it a reading? Is it a prayer? What is its purpose?

In the ancient Church, the Responsorial Psalm was very much the same as it is today. There was a response sung by all, followed by the text of a particular Psalm chosen for that day, followed again by the response. The key difference was the length—in the ancient Church, the Psalm was sung in its entirety. Today, only selected verses of a Psalm are used. The purpose of the Responsorial Psalm was to respond prayerfully and lyrically to the message of the readings that had just been proclaimed.

As time passed, the Responsorial Psalm grew shorter, and slowly ceased to be a response at all. In the Extraordinary Form, for example, the priest will recite the entire psalm, which may consist of just a single verse. Trends in sacred music made the Psalm more and more elaborate. Eventually, the response intended for the people became too difficult, and was performed entirely by the choir. After the Second Vatican Council, the ancient responsorial format was reintroduced. This is the format we see at Mass today.

The Responsorial Psalm is part of the Liturgy of the Word, but the Psalm is definitely not “just another reading.” It is actually a prayer in its own right. Have you ever noticed that in every Psalm, the people address God directly with their words? That's what prayer is—words we speak to God. That's why the Psalm is always participatory. We don't merely listen to it like we do the other readings, but we pray it.

And interestingly enough, it is not called the “Responsorial Psalm” because there is a response for people to sing. It is called the “Responsorial Psalm” for the same reason used in the ancient Church—because it is the prayerful reflection of the people on the proclamation of the reading that just took place. The Psalm is related to the theme of the Old Testament reading and the Gospel. Thus, the people “respond” to the Word of God, make it their own, and proclaim it prayerfully.

The one fact to remember about the Responsorial Psalm is that it's meant to be a prayer. Do you deliberately pray the Responsorial Psalm? Try it next Sunday, and begin to make it a habit.

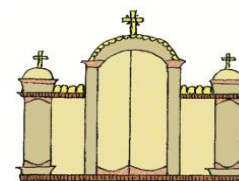

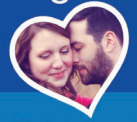
