## Next Week, Please Help the Crosier Fathers and Brothers Mission in Indonesia

Next Sunday, we will take a special collection to support the Crosier Fathers and Brothers mission in Indonesia. The Diocese has selected the Crosier Fathers for this year's annual Mission Cooperative Plan Appeal. This appeal helps people who do not have access to basic pastoral services such as Mass, the sacraments, religious education, as well as providing the most basic needs – food, shelter, and healthcare. This appeal will also help train locals to become catechists, teachers, and nurses.

The Crosier Fathers and Brothers have been serving the people of Indonesia for nearly 90 years. In 1958, the Crosiers began serving the Asmat people in the region of Papua, Indonesia. Currently, ten Crosiers serve four parishes in that area. They also began a vocational tech school to teach the Catholic faith while helping children develop marketable skills to prepare them to enter the workforce.

The best way to donate to this appeal is by check. Simply make your check payable to St. Theresa, and be sure to put "MCP" in the memo line. That will make sure the funds go to the "Mission Cooperative Plan" this year. You may drop a check in the collection basket, or in the boxes by the exits of church.

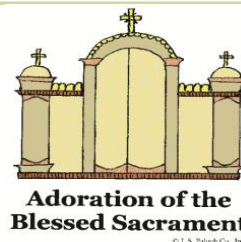

### Sponsor Certificates

Please contact the Parish Office to obtain a sponsor certificate prior to a Baptism or Confirmation.

### Baptisms

Parents desiring Baptism for their child must attend a class, preferably before the child's birth. The classes are held the first Thursday of each month at 7:30pm in the Louis Martin Conference Room in the Administration Bldg. After you attend the class, you may schedule your child for the Sacrament of Baptism (Sundays 1:30pm). Date is confirmed once all paperwork is received in the office. Forms can be found on the Parish website under Faith, Sacraments, Baptism.

### Matrimony

The priest must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.
