The Important Difference Between Religion and Ideology

One of my favorite quotations comes from the late Francis Cardinal George, Archbishop of Chicago, “Modern man is incapable of thinking in terms other than politics and psychology.” In our own time, an ever-growing secularism has diminished the sense of God's providence—that is, of God's real activity both in history and the life of each individual. Politics and psychology rush in to fill the void, but none other than God can satisfy the weary human heart, or show the way to peace in a troubled world. Cardinal George's observation is the root cause behind another unfortunate reality in our own time—the rise of ideology and the decline of religion. I believe it is very important to understand the distinction between the two.

In *The Imitation of Christ* Thomas a Kempis writes, “Why do you wish to change the world when you cannot change yourself?” This question sums up the essential difference between religion and ideology—religion understands all lasting change in the world begins with personal repentance. Ideology, by contrast, seeks to change other people while ignoring the need to reform one's own self.

Pope Francis has spoken about this critical difference in some of his daily homilies. As he said on April 19, 2013,

An ideology tries to change the world (or create an isolated utopia) through a set of beliefs and a code of behavior. “If only everyone would only join our group, follow our code of action, our set of beliefs, our political or economic theories,” says the ideologue, “then the world would be a perfect place!”

Behold, the central problem in the mind of the ideologue—other people! Others need to fall into line. Others need to conform to our thinking. Others need to change their ways. Always the focus is on changing others, never on changing one's self. If only others would adopt the correct ideology we could create utopia, without any personal reform or sacrifice on my part—otherwise known as the love of God and neighbor. Can you see how futile and divisive this effort is?

Ideologies are usually political or economic, but beware, they often masquerade as religion, and dupe many people. True religion is very different. As St. James tells us, “true religion is to visit the widow and the fatherless in their affliction, and to keep one's self unspotted by the world” (Ja 1:27). Religion never begins with a desire to change the world, but with a concern for God and others and the need to reform one's own self. And one beautiful consequence of it is the true and lasting reform that follows.

Our Lord told us, “The first commandment is this: love the Lord your God with all your soul, heart, mind and strength, and your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets” (Matt 22:37). Do this and you will change yourself. Do this and you will change your community. Do this and you will change the world.

God bless you, and St. Theresa, pray for us!
