Do Sundays "Count" as Days of Lent?

The short answer is, "yes, they do!" There's a rumor abuzz that Sundays do not count as days of Lent. Let's set the record straight.

Everyone knows there are 40 days of Lent, but if you count the number of days from Ash Wednesday to Easter Sunday, you will discover there are 46 days, not 40. Now, there are six Sundays between Ash Wednesday and Easter. Therefore, according to popular rumor, we should subtract the six Sundays from Lent, treat each one as a "little Easter," and take a break from our Lenten penance. In this way, we're left with a perfect 40 days of Lent...correct?

Incorrect. There are three facts we must remember.

Fact #1: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday are not days of Lent. According to the *General Norms for the Liturgical Year and the Calendar*, "Lent runs from Ash Wednesday until the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday." Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday (known as the Sacred Triduum) have never been part of the season of Lent. The Sacred Triduum is in a class all by itself.

Fact #2: Before the Second Vatican Council (1963-1965), the season of Lent did not begin on Ash Wednesday as it does now, but on the First Sunday of Lent. Back then, Ash Wednesday was not part of Lent. Rather, it was part of a three-week "pre-Lenten" season, which Vatican II abolished. However, when the Church abolished the "pre-Lenten" season, it retained Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday was just too popular to eliminate. As a result, Vatican II actually added four days to Lent. Yes, since Vatican II, Lent actually has 44 days, not 40. There are exactly 40 days from the First Sunday of Lent until Holy Thursday, but since Lent now begins on Ash Wednesday, it's now 44 days long. The perfect 40-day count no longer exists.

Fact #3: The Code of Canon Law (C.I.C.) tells us:

- 1) That every Christian should do penance during Lent, each in his or her own way (C.I.C. 1249)
- 2) That the entire season of Lent is a penitential time in the Church (C.I.C. 1250)
- 3) Solemnities in Lent, even when they fall on a Friday, are not days of abstinence from meat. (C.I.C. 1251)

Every Sunday is a high feast day known as a Solemnity, but even in Lent, they are still days of penance. They're just not days of abstinence from meat, which you probably weren't doing on Sunday anyways. People sometimes ask, "can you take a break from your penance on a Sunday in Lent?" You may if you wish, because the penance you undertake is personal and binding on your own authority. But as you take a break from penance, please do not forget that the six Sundays of Lent are part of the Lenten season. It's not Easter yet. Personally, I like to press through the whole of Lent without relaxing my penance at all, but it's up to you. Let's treasure these days of Lent as a chance to renew our hearts.





Assistive Listening Devices Update

The assistive listening system in the church has been enhanced for improved amplification.
