A Brief History of the Stations of the Cross

The Stations of the Cross is a beloved devotion for any time of year, but is especially honored during Lent. The fourteen Stations which adorn the aisles of nearly every Catholic Church in the world have evolved over time. Let's take a quick look at the history of this devotion.

According to pious tradition, it was the Blessed Virgin Mary who first visited the scenes of our Lord's passion along the streets of ancient Jerusalem, but when the Roman Emperor Constantine legalized Christianity in the year 312, a path through the city was formally marked with small churches at the various locations where Jesus himself had once walked. St. Jerome (342-420), living in Bethlehem, attested to the crowds of pilgrims from many countries who visited those holy places and followed the Way of the Cross.

By the fifth century, some churches in Europe had begun to create replicas of the holy places of Jerusalem for the many people who were unable to travel to the Holy Land. For example, St. Petronius, Bishop of Bologna, constructed a group of chapels at the monastery of San Stefano, which depicted the more important shrines of the Holy Land, including several of the Stations of the Cross. But the Stations of the Cross we know today did not develop until the 15th century, when the Turkish conquest of the Holy Land made a pilgrimage to Jerusalem a practical impossibility.

The Stations of the Cross have not always been the same fourteen Stations we know today. Both the number of the Stations and the names have varied greatly. A few Stations of the Cross which once existed include: Christ passes through the gates of Jerusalem; Christ visits the House of King Herod; and Christ passes the house of Simon the Pharisee.

By the end of the 17th century, Stations of the Cross had become very popular, but the number and variety of Stations had begun to confuse the faithful. Some churches had fourteen Stations, while others had as many as seventeen Stations. And so, in 1731, Pope Clement XII fixed the number at fourteen—and formally established the same Stations we know today. In 1742, Pope Benedict XIV exhorted all priests to enrich their churches with the Way of the Cross, and stated that a cross must accompany each Station, even if a depiction of the scene itself is impossible. This is why even today, you will see some "Stations of the Cross" consisting of nothing but small crosses and roman numerals.

Here at St. Theresa, we celebrate the Stations of the Cross every Friday evening in Lent, beginning at 7:30pm. I wish you the best as you continue your Lenten fasting, alms, and prayer—especially the Stations of the Cross!

Birthright is Seeking a New Executive Director

Birthright of Loudoun, located in historic Leesburg, VA, is a non-profit organization that provides counseling, resources, and material support for any woman who finds herself in an unexpected or crisis pregnancy.

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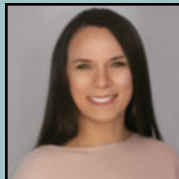
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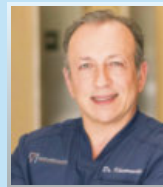
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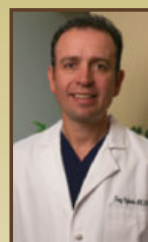
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
