#### The Monthly Devotions of the Year—May

Each month of the year is traditionally devoted to one single aspect of our Catholic faith. In May, it is the Blessed Virgin Mary. This devotion arose among Jesuits in Rome in the late 18th century and quickly spread throughout the Western Church. By the time of Pope Pius IX's declaration of the dogma of the Immaculate Conception in 1854, it had become universal. Because Mother's Day falls in May, it's also a perfect time to consider Mary's role as our mother.

There are lots of ways to dedicate May to the Blessed Mother. Here at St. Theresa, you will see our Blessed Mother statue wearing a crown of flowers this month. This is known as the "May Crowning" and is a traditional Catholic sign of love and affection for Mary, who is both Mother and Queen. Especially this month, I highly recommend daily praying of the Holy Rosary. Not only is the Rosary the single greatest prayer outside of the Sacred Liturgy, but there's just "something" about making it a daily prayer that you have to experience for yourself to understand. To me, it is like an impenetrable shield against ceaseless, daily spiritual attacks that I encounter in my life.

Here's a prayer for this month that I would like to share with you. The author is a 19th century French Jesuit priest who was particularly noted for his love for the mother of Jesus. It's one of my favorite prayers, and I hope it might become one of yours.

Holy Mary, Mother of God, Preserve in me the heart of a child, Pure and clean like spring water. A simple heart that does not remain absorbed in its own sadness. A loving heart that freely gives with compassion. A faithful and generous heart that neither forgets any good, nor feels bitterness for any evil. Give me a humble heart that loves without asking to be loved in return, happy to lose itself in the heart of others, sacrificing itself in front of your Divine Son. A great and unconquerable heart, which no ingratitude can close and no indifference can tire. A heart tormented by the glory of Christ, pierced by his love with a wound that will not heal until heaven.




