#### From Fr. Vaccaro

Hello St Theresa parish family!

I arrived at the parish on Thursday, and I am happy to be joining you here. I wanted to share a few things about myself that you may find interesting.

I grew up as a parishioner at St. Michael's in Annandale with my wonderful parents and three brothers and three sisters. Two of my brothers are also priests. My youngest brother, Father Stephen, is currently assigned in Winchester at Sacred Heart and my older brother, Father Brian, is currently assigned in Mexico. He is a member of a religious order the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, or more commonly known as Redemptorists. I like to say that since I was the first of the three ordained, I should be given the title "the greater". I am not sure they agree with that.

I have been a priest for 15 years, serving at Holy Spirit in Annandale, Our Lady of Angels in Woodbridge and most recently for nine years as chaplain at the University of Mary Washington in Fredericksburg. During that time, I lived with Father Hudgins for five of those nine years while he was pastor at St. Jude's. We enjoyed our time together and he, as you know, is a very kind and hard-working priest. It was a great joy to serve alongside the wonderful young men and women at UMW. I have a specific concern for, and place in my heart for, young adults. I have found in my time as a priest that many of them are waiting for the invitation to the greatness of living the Catholic Faith fully. With Father Hudgins' blessing, it is my hope to start something to particularly support the young adults of the parish.

A few things that I enjoy are walking (I walk at least 5 miles a day), going out to eat with friends, and officiating high school basketball. I have been officiating for more than 20 years and have refereed 2 state finals and 3 state semi-finals. Thankfully both priests and basketball referees wear black and white:)

I look forward to meeting all of you. Please add me to your prayer intentions, if you would, and know that I am asking the Lord to bless each of your families.




