A Study of the Angels, Continued: The Powers

Let's continue studying about the angels. As you might recall from previous bulletin columns, there are nine "choirs" of angels in the celestial hierarchy. So far, we have looked at the lowest three choirs: the Angels, Archangels, and Principalities. Today we consider the next highest choir—known as the Powers.

First, let's review. An angel "choir" is not a musical group. "Choir" refers to the perfection of an angel's being—essentially, a choir is an angelic rank. The first three choirs (Seraphim, Cherubim, Thrones) are the direct and immediate servants of God himself. The second three choirs (Dominions, Virtues, Powers) are known as the "angels of creation" because they concern themselves with the ordering of the universe. The third sphere of angels (Principalities, Archangels, Angels) are those with direct ministry to human beings.

The name "Powers" sounds odd to modern ears, but makes sense upon closer examination. These angels have been entrusted with a defensive task given to no other created spirit. Think of the Powers as warrior angels, for the cause of God's goodness. Their appointed task is to fight demonic spirits. The evil spirits do not take "vacation" from seeking to disorder God's creation, especially in the hearts of men and women. The Powers are a major line of defense, in God's plan, for our well-being. Just as we rely on the ceaseless efforts of military, police, and other law-enforcement agencies to guarantee the peace in our society, so we rely on the unseen Powers to combat the restless machinations of malevolent spirits.

The choir of Powers appears twice in scripture:

God raised Christ from the dead and made him sit at his right hand in the heavenly places, far above every Principality, Power, Virtue, and Dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. (Eph. 1:20-21)

Jesus Christ has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, Powers, and Virtues subject to him. (1 Pet 3:21-22)

According to the writings of some early Fathers, the Powers have an additional task: guarding the priest in the exercise of his ministries. Heaven knows we can use all the help we can get!


To learn about the angels is to enter into a realm of mystery. Our knowledge of such lofty realities is remote and imperfect—almost like the knowledge an animal might have if it attempted to understand a human being. As we study even higher ranks of angels in the weeks to come, they're going to seem even more mysterious. So, please remember, these mysterious angels actually exist. They know us, love us, and lead us to our ultimate destination of Heaven.

You may schedule your child for the Sacrament of Baptism (held all Sundays 1:30pm) by visiting the Parish website under Faith, Sacraments, Baptism. Date is confirmed once all paperwork is received in the office (at least 2 weeks prior to the date of desired Baptism.)

Matrimony

The priest must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.

Adults desiring instruction in the Catholic Faith should visit the website to register for RCIA classes.






