#### The Hardest to Tame is the Tongue

Why is it so easy to speak words we later regret? Why is it so hard to control the tongue? It's because the heart is a very difficult thing to change. Jesus said, "out of the heart's abundance, the mouth speaks," (Lk 6:45).

Four Scriptures to tame the tongue:

Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O Lord, my rescuer and my rock, (Ps 19:14).

Keep my tongue from evil, and my lips from speaking deceit, (Ps 34:13).

Say only the good things men need to hear, things that will really help them, (Eph 4:29).

Set a guard over my mouth, O Lord. Keep watch over the door of my lips, (Ps 141:3).

The Nine Sins of the tongue:

**Lying** – Jesus once said that Satan is the Father of lies, and lying is his native speech. Two simple words to live by—speak truth! Never speak a falsehood with the intent of deceiving someone else.

**Flattery** – Flattery is the exaggeration of the good qualities of another in order to ingratiate ourselves to them. God hates flattery, (Ps 12:3). Never praise someone else, except in sincerity and self-forgetfulness.

**Bragging** - Everyone hates a braggart. Not only does the braggart learn nothing from others, he usually appears ignorant, despite what he thinks of himself. "The wise man does not make a show of his knowledge, but fools broadcast their ignorance," (Prov 12:23).

**Imprudent Words** - Proverbs 10:19 says that the prudent hold their tongues. Do not spread confidential information, except when absolutely necessary. James 1:19 tells us to be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to anger.

**Prejudiced Words** – Just as St. James tells us never to speak without listening, so too must we be careful to speak from prejudice, that is to say, to speak without thinking. Tradition sometimes calls this the fault of being "quick of tongue."

**Deliberate Provocation** – To speak in an overly opinionated way is a veiled personal attack. It provokes anger, division, and hurt. "A fool finds no pleasure in understanding, but delights in airing his own opinions," (Prov 18:2).

**Backbiting** – A backbiter is the one who speaks against another in his absence, injuring another's reputation through detraction. Never repeat gossip. If you hear something unsavory from another, let those words die with you.

**Cursing** – To curse is to wish harm upon another—often that they be damned, and often invoking the name of God to do so. Let's bless those who curse us, just as Jesus taught.

**Silence** – Failure to speak when we ought, such as to warn someone of danger—including sin—is also a misuse of speech. Let's pray that no one would say of us what Isaiah said of the Israelites, "Israel's watchmen are blind. They are like dumb dogs that cannot bark," (Is 56:10).

God bless you...and St. Theresa, pray for us!

# How to Register to be a Parishioner of St. Theresa Catholic Church

In the sacramental life of the Church, Catholic faithful will In order to register, come to the parish office Monday need to prove residency in a parish. Registration with the parish office allows us to track your sacramental data and keep you connected with the life of the church.

Friday 9:30am – 3:30pm to fill out a registration card. Yellow registration cards can also be obtained at all of the Church entrances - these can be mailed to the parish or given to an usher during a church liturgy.

#### **Parish Offices**




