The Power of Imagination

"Whatever is true, whatever is modest, whatever is just, whatever is holy, whatever is of virtue—think about these things," (Phil 4:8).

Here's a big spiritual idea that doesn't get much attention—the power of your imagination, for good or for bad. C.S. Lewis once said that there is no neutral ground in the universe. Every square inch of matter, and every split second of eternity are claimed by God and counter-claimed by Satan. Imagination isn't neutral ground either. It's either an incalculable asset or a great hindrance on the path to heaven. An imagination purified for God's service makes spiritual things come naturally. An uncontrolled imagination by contrast, makes a spiritual life much harder. It paints in vivid colors all the pleasures sin might provide you, and over-emphasizes the difficulty saying "yes" to God. An untamed imagination and a sad heart usually come together, as a package-deal. Here's a few ideas to help re-direct the power of your imagination to the service of God.

Careful What You See Imagination doesn't spring out of nothing. It retains, reproduces, and reassembles ideas in a thousand ways—and all these begin with sight. It's why spiritual writers for centuries spoke of the custody of the eyes (custodia oculorum). We can't always choose what we see—but we can choose whether or not to take a second look, or to dwell on an image that will not help us.

Careful What You Read Once upon a time, St. Ignatius of Loyola was laying in a hospital, and asked for something to read. He had two choices—the lives of the saints, or adventure stories. First, he chose the adventure stories. Although they were enjoyable, they left him feeling uninspired and empty. Next, he read the lives of the saints. These were not exciting, but they left him inspired to be a better person. Be careful what you read. It's one thing to avoid reading that is obviously sinful, but we should also avoid reading what's empty and useless. Dedicate your attention to what builds you up.

Avoid Sloth The imagination is never quiet. If we don't keep it occupied with something good, it will find something harmful to settle on. Learn the difference between leisure and laziness.

Age Quod Agis That's an old Latin expression that means, "Do what you're doing." In other words, be attentive to the duty of the moment. Isn't it amazing how we can fritter away time, accomplish nothing, and not even enjoy ourselves in the process? Whether at work, rest, or play, choose to act deliberately. Do what you're doing, with your whole heart. You'll find this practice strengthens your mind against distractions too.

Deliberately Ignore Toxic Thoughts Sometimes, the only way to fight a bad imagination is to attack it directly. This is the advice of St. Teresa of Avila. Yes, you can do this! When life delivers up toxic thoughts—just refuse delivery. Choose another thought—such as a happy memory, or a pressing obligation—but fight back. Most of all, be patient with yourself. You'll get better at this with practice.




