A Study of the Angels, Continued: The Virtues and the Dominions

Let's continue studying about the angels. As you might recall from previous bulletin columns, there are nine "choirs" of angels in the celestial hierarchy. We're currently looking at the middle three choirs: the Dominions, the Virtues, and the Powers. There are known as the "angels of creation" because they concern themselves with the ordering of the universe. Last time, we considered the Powers. Today let's consider the Virtues and the Dominions.

The higher the object of our study, the more imperfect our knowledge becomes. Whereas we can have perfect knowledge of lower things—such as plants, animals, and minerals—the study of higher things—such as God and the angels—is shrouded in mystery, and our knowledge will always be imperfect. As a consequence, we don't know very much about these angels. The following is a summary of the traditions we've been given.

The Virtues

The names of some choirs of angels seem strange to us, but do make sense upon closer examination. "Virtue" is a word most often used to refer to actions, not to living beings. However, the choir of Virtues are said to be agents of God's actions on earth and therefore act as agents of divine perfection. Perfection is part of the meaning of the word "virtue," which derives from the Latin word *virtus* meaning perfection, excellence, or courage. It is believed that the Virtues oversee the movements of planets, stars, and the forces of nature according to God's design. Other duties traditionally associated with the Virtues are the working of public signs and miracles, and the encouragement the faithful in such matters as patience and perseverance.

The choir of Virtues appears twice in scripture:

God raised Christ from the dead and made him sit at his right hand in the heavenly places, far above every Principality, Power, Virtue, and Dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. (Eph. 1:20-21)

Jesus Christ has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, Powers, and Virtues subject to him. (1 Pet 3:21-22)

Artists have depicted the choir of Virtues in many different fashions. Some have shown them carrying white lilies for perfection, or red roses to symbolize Christ's passionate love. Because of their connection to God's power over the elements of nature, Virtues are also depicted holding the earth in their hands.

The Dominions

The word "Dominions" comes from the Latin word *dominus*, meaning "master" or "Lord." In fact, these angels are sometimes called "Lords," because they reveal God's majesty to other angels. The choir of Dominions appears once in the New Testament, apart from the passage from Ephesians, cited earlier.

For in him were created all things in heaven and on earth, the visible and the invisible, whether Thrones or Dominions or Principalities or Powers; all things were created through him and for him. (Col 1:16)

Although angels are beings of pure spirit and have no visible form, we still depict them according to familiar patterns. Dominions are depicted by the most traditional fashion: divinely beautiful human beings with a pair of feathered wings. They are distinguished from other angelic groups by wielding orbs of light, or by carrying a scroll, representing the will of God which they are tasked with sharing.

Jesus once told us, "You know how the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and how their great ones make their authority over them felt. It shall not be so among you." Similarly, the choir of Dominions reminds us that only those who obey God are fit to rule others.






