If You Believe in What We Do, Please Contribute to St. Theresa

Just once per year, I need to remind everyone how important it is to give to the collection. That's my only message, this week. Please allow me a chance to explain. The work of this parish is made possible only by free will offerings—exclusively and entirely. We receive no money from the Diocese. Very simply, without your help St. Theresa cannot fulfill its mission. If you believe in what we do here, then humbly I ask, please help us pay the bills.

This is a sacred obligation which falls upon each of us. In fact, one of the seven Precepts of the Church is, "to provide for the material needs of the parish, each according to his own ability." We do not contribute to our parish simply because there is an immediate need. We contribute because it's the right thing to do. I ask only that you give as you are able. You owe it to God, and to your fellow parishioners.

St. Theresa parish is supported by the generosity of just a fraction of our families. More than half the families in the pews do not contribute anything, and that's just wrong. Here's an interesting statistic. Our collection would increase by 40% if those who give nothing would simply offer the average gift of \$15. Sometimes, people say "I have children in St. Theresa School. I pay plenty already in tuition." Please understand, tuition only pays a fraction of the cost of operating the school. The parish subsidizes the rest. A child in St. Theresa school is a reason to give even more generously, but it's not a reason to avoid giving.

Just like last year, I wish to emphasize giving by Faith Direct, our electronic giving program that helps St. Theresa even more than giving in the collection basket does. Faith Direct saves your parish time and money, because it minimizes the time and effort we must dedicate to counting and tabulating the collection each week. Furthermore, when the snow falls and people stay home, our collection goes down dramatically. But Faith Direct protects your parish when that happens, because your giving is automated. As always, you decide the contribution amount, and control it, because you contribute via automatic payment from your checking account or credit card.

Take a look at the Faith Direct website, www.faithdirect.net, for more information or to securely enroll online by using our parish code: VA14. I have complete trust in this program, and I have enrolled in it myself. I hope you will begin using Faith Direct. It's simply the most effective way to give to St. Theresa.

Again, I ask you: please help your parish. Without you, we can't keep going. With your help, we can do so much more. Thank you for being a part of St. Theresa!

God bless you, and St. Theresa, pray for us!






