The Monthly Devotions of the Year—October

Each month of the year is traditionally devoted to one single aspect of our Catholic faith. The Holy Rosary is our devotion for the month of October, for reasons dating back more than four centuries. In the year 1571, Turks of the Ottoman Empire threatened to invade and conquer Europe. Theirs was the mightiest navy in the world—so powerful in fact that they had not lost a battle for nearly 200 years. Pope St. Pius V was keenly aware of this threat, and called on Christians throughout Europe to storm heaven with prayers—especially the prayer of the Rosary—for the protection and defense of the people. In one of the most consequential battles in all history, the Battle of Lepanto, fought off the southern shores of Greece on October 7, 1571, a combined fleet of Catholic maritime states decisively defeated the invading forces of the Ottomans in a victory that Pope St. Pius V immediately attributed to the intercession of the Blessed Mother before the throne of God. The Pope proclaimed October 7 to be a new feast day—the feast of Our Lady of Victory—known today as the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.

We are still in a battle today. Ours is not a battle between nation-states fought with ships and guns, but rather, a spiritual battle. The belligerents are the angels and the saints, Lucifer and the demons, Our Lord and the Blessed Mother... and you! Our weapons are prayer, penance, fasting, almsgiving, humility, and deep faith. In this war, the stakes could not be higher. It is your immortal soul and those of your friends and family that hang in the balance. And in this war, saints down through history have repeatedly recommended the Rosary as one of the most powerful weapons of all.

Why the Rosary? Because in the Rosary we unite ourselves to Jesus by meditating on his life, death, resurrection, and ascension while asking continually for the powerful intercession of the Blessed Mother for ourselves and for those we love—both now, and at the hour of our death. There's "something" I can't describe about the Rosary that you simply must experience for yourself—it has the power to defeat sin in your life. It is not magic—one must persevere, receive the sacraments, and put forth real effort—but it has power. And it comes with the universal recommendation of the saints who have gone before us—and they're our real heroes in this fight.

Would you like to learn more about the Rosary? Would you like a Rosary for free? Contact the office, or ask any of our Legion of Mary volunteers. They will be happy to help you get started with this beautiful and life-changing prayer. I hope you will discover it for yourself, because in these challenging times, we need all the prayers we can get.

God bless you, and St. Theresa, pray for us!

You may schedule your child for the Sacrament of Baptism (held all Sundays 1:30pm) by visiting the Parish website under Faith, Sacraments, Baptism. Date is confirmed once all paperwork is received in the office (at least 2 weeks prior to the date of desired Baptism.)

Matrimony

The priest must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.
