A Study of the Angels, Continued: The Thrones

Let's continue studying about the angels. First, let's review. As you might recall from previous bulletin columns, there are nine "choirs" of angels in the celestial hierarchy. An angel "choir" is not a musical group. "Choir" refers to the perfection of an angel's being—essentially, a choir is an angelic rank.

Thus far, we've looked at the lowest grouping of the choirs of angels (Principalities, Archangels, Angels), who have direct ministry to human beings. We've also looked at the second grouping of angels (Dominions, Virtues, Powers), who concern themselves with the ordering of material creation. Today, we look at the highest sphere of angels, who are the direct and immediate servants of God himself. These angels are known as the Cherubim, Seraphim, and Thrones. Among these three, the Thrones are the lowest choir.

Whereas the Seraphim contemplate God's glory, and the Cherubim contemplate God's providence, it is said that the Thrones contemplate God's justice. In fact, the name "thrones" derives from the vision of the prophet Daniel:

> As I watched, thrones were set up and the Ancient of Days took his throne. His clothing was white as snow, the hair on his head like pure wool. His throne was flames of fire, with wheels of burning fire. A river of fire surged forth, flowing from where he sat. Thousands upon thousands were ministering to him, and myriads upon myriads stood before him. (Dan 7:9-10)

When the Bible speaks of God as seated "on a throne," it's important to note that we Catholics do not believe there is a mystical, literal "chair" existing somewhere in the universe and that God almighty is using it to rest his tired bones. A "throne," rather, is emblematic of royal authority, and the "throne of God" is a metaphor for God's omnipotence. God delegates his works to his creatures. Only God gives us life, for example, and yet God himself delegates this work to mothers and fathers. Only God forgives sin, for example, and yet God has delegated this work to priests and bishops. Similarly, God's work in the universe employs the delegated assistance of his angels, and the choir of Thrones are instrumental in meting out the justice of God, wherever divine omnipotence wills it to have effect.

Although angels are beings of pure spirit, many angels have appeared to human beings under an assumed human form. Thrones, however, are thought to appear most unlike all the other choirs of angels. In Christian art, they have been depicted as wheels, rotating rings, flames, and even as eyes!

Please remember that the study of mysterious things, such as God and the angels, requires of us an ample measure of humility. There's very little we can know for sure, and so much that will remain a mystery. One day, please God, we will know the angels as our personal friends and companions in God's presence in heaven.




