#### What Can We Do About Sadness?

There's nothing wrong with you, just for feeling sad. Even the saints had sad days, believe it or not. Some days, we can't manage to overcome an inner torpor which weighs us down on us and makes it difficult to interact with others. Is there anything we can do to overcome sorrow and recover our smile? Here are five "remedies for sadness" taken from St. Thomas Aquinas.

**Have an Edible Treat:** I'm no M.D., but I think chocolate might be an antidepressant. The first remedy for sadness is to head to the refrigerator, or maybe the 7-Eleven, and get something you like. This might seem shallow, but it's hard to refute. There's abundant evidence to prove it—a little edible treat can really boost your mood. The Gospels narrate how our Lord took part in banquets and feasts, both before and after his Resurrection, and showed us that joy and a treat go together harmoniously. Just remember to take it all in moderation. I can confirm from firsthand experience that even a bad day ends well with a frosted cookie.

**Go Ahead and Cry:** St. Thomas says that hurtful things hurt even more if we keep them bottled up, because the soul is more focused on them. However, if a hurt is allowed to escape, our focus is dispersed, and sorrow is lessened. That's why deep sadness has to be vented. Weeping is nature's way of letting it out. The shortest verse in the Bible is John 11:35, "Jesus wept." If it's good for Jesus, it's good for you too. As Pope Francis recently said, "There are certain truths in life can only be seen with eyes cleansed by tears."

**Talk It Out:** You know this one from experience. When we are sad, we see everything from our own point of view only. All reality appears monochrome grey. We forget that our perception is only a faint sliver of reality. Opening your heart to a friend, even with just a simple phone call, is enough to change your entire outlook. They say that the definition of a friend is "someone who knows all about you, but still loves you anyway." Talking with a friend is one of the fastest ways to see beyond yourself, and get a handle on your sorrow.

**Get Outdoors:** God's creation in nature is sometimes called the "Fifth Gospel"—a beautiful message for you, written by the hand of God himself. St. Thomas tells us that God is the "fulgor veritatis"—the splendor of the truth. That's why an effective balm against sadness is to meet the splendor of the Creator in the beauty of his creation. Get beyond the sound of traffic. Listen to the rhythm of the ocean. Hear the songs of the birds. Rediscover just how refreshing is the scent of clean air. Gaze up at the majesty of the skies, and remember...God is bigger than your sadness. Stick close to him, and he will prove it to you.

**A Hot Bath and a Good Night's Sleep:** The fifth remedy against sadness isn't something you'd expect from a 13th century theologian, but St. Thomas actually states that cleanliness followed by a good night's sleep is a great antidote to sadness. "The body and soul are so closely united that together they form a single person, and the malady of one can be the malady of both," he writes. Put it all behind you, and start again tomorrow. Those are just a few words of advice from St. Thomas Aquinas, whose wisdom is just as true today as it ever was.

Assistive Listening Devices. Did you know one out of every 8 adults in the U. S. has some difficulty hearing even when using a hearing aid? That means that on any given weekend, hundreds of our congregation are missing much of what is being said at Mass. To help them, St. Theresa's has an assistive listening system in the church that can be accessed by wearing compatible headphones (or an earpiece) with a receiver that amplifies the voices heard over the sound system. A neck loop is also available for people who have hearing aids or cochlear implants with the telecoil (t-coil) function. These assisted listening devices can be checked out from an usher before Mass. 
