#### The Monthly Devotions of the Year—November

Each month of the year is traditionally devoted to one single aspect of our Catholic faith. In the month of November, we remember to pray for the souls of the deceased.

Christ came to this world to offer himself as a ransom for our sins. He did so, perfectly, by his death on the cross. But just because Jesus gives us his grace does not mean all will accept it. Sadly, many will reject God's grace entirely. Some will accept it fully, and some will accept God's grace, but only partially. What happens to them? Many of our friends and relatives were alive with God's grace, but died still clinging to venial sins—what happens to them? Before such souls can enter into the perfection of Heaven, they must be cleansed of their defects in Purgatory—a place of temporary purification for those who have died in God's grace, but still stained by sin and attachment to sin.

We're all conscious of sins for which we're not very repentant, or which we would commit again if the opportunity arose. This is the state in which many live, also the state in which many die. We're weak creatures, and we like our faults. But heaven is a place of perfect love, with no selfishness whatsoever. Certainly it is possible to die in a state of perfect love for God and others, but for those whose love is partial, there must be purification. By God's grace, our prayers can help.

St. Ambrose addressed this matter beautifully and succinctly—"Those whom we have loved in this life we must not abandon in death, until by the help of our prayers, we have carried them safely to the house of the Lord." The greatest prayer of all is the Mass, and we should have Mass said for our deceased relatives and friends. Let's remember what the Mass is: no less than the event of Christ's suffering and death on Calvary, made a present reality to us by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Each Mass here at St. Theresa is offered for an intention announced just before Mass. I keep that name in mind as I pray, remembering that that soul in particular was saved by Christ on the cross, and asking God's mercy for all the sins of their lifetime. I myself offer several Masses each month for the souls of my own relatives and friends too. My father died when I was three years old. I offered my very first Mass for his soul, and I continue to offer Mass for his soul two or three times each month. What if he has already gone to heaven and does not need my prayers anymore? Then God, in his goodness, will use the value of the Mass to help someone else in need. No prayer is ever wasted. But since I do not know, I keep praying.

Please remember that one Mass prayed well during your life is more powerful than one said for you after your death. So join me in each Mass, please, with all your heart. But nonetheless, never forget the spiritual value of prayer for the deceased, especially during this month of November. One day, we hope to be with them in the heavenly kingdom, where there will be no more death, and every tear will be wiped away.

God bless you, and St. Theresa, pray for us!

Assistive Listening Devices. Did you know one out of every 8 adults in the U. S. has some difficulty hearing even when using a hearing aid? That means that on any given weekend, hundreds of our congregation are missing much of what is being said at Mass. To help them, St. Theresa's has an assistive listening system in the church that can be accessed by wearing compatible headphones (or an earpiece) with a receiver that amplifies the voices heard over the sound system. A neck loop is also available for people who have hearing aids or cochlear implants with the telecoil (t-coil) function. These assisted listening devices can be checked out from an usher before Mass. 


