An Act of Mercy for Your Family

November is the month traditionally dedicated to the prayerful memory of the deceased. It's an act of mercy to pray for the souls of those who have gone before us, but there's another act of mercy that needs your attention: planning your own funeral and burial arrangements. It's not a pleasant task, but the better you prepare, the less your loved ones will need to worry in an already painful time. I plan to write a few articles here in the bulletin to help you do this.

The first thing to consider is whether you wish to be buried or cremated. At one time, the Church did not permit cremation. This was largely because enemies of the Church sometimes imposed cremation upon all the faithful, including the scattering of ashes. This was done to ridicule the Church's belief in the resurrection, or as a way of trying to obliterate the memory of a martyr for the faith. More recently, the Church has permitted cremation, simply because the former reasons for objecting to it no longer apply. However, please note the Church's preference is still for burial with a casket.

But whether by cremation or casket, the deceased is to be buried — they must not be placed in the home, or scattered on land or at sea. Whenever possible, Catholics should be buried in the consecrated ground of a Catholic cemetery, but if a Catholic cemetery is not available, other cemeteries may be chosen. Furthermore, this does not have to be in a grave. Interment in a columbarium or mausoleum is perfectly respectful and proper. Lastly, when choosing a grave marker or headstone, be sure to mark it prominently with a sign of your faith, such as with an etching of a cross or crucifix.

Another item you should clarify is your wish for a funeral Mass, in Church. I have known many devoted souls whose children did not give their parents the gift of a funeral Mass, and so I ask you, please state this wish in writing, among your official documents. There may be times that a funeral Mass might not be chosen, such as a deep wound in the family which might be torn open in the context of Church, but I doubt this applies to most of you. Nonetheless, even if a funeral Mass is not chosen, a memorial Mass should be celebrated as soon as possible. There's no prayer more powerful than Mass, and once we're gone, we need all the prayer we can get!

Lastly, we remember to show our love for the deceased through our prayer. Please tell your loved ones that you want Mass offered for you in the years after your departure from this life. Ideal dates for these Masses include your birthday, your anniversary date, or any other date you might find meaningful. Please understand, it's not always possible to get a specific date for a Mass intention, and what matters most is that the prayer of the Mass is offered, regardless of the date. If you'd like Mass offered after you have passed, it's a good idea to make this wish known in writing. We will continue this same topic, next week.

God bless you, and St. Theresa pray for us!

Assistive Listening Devices. Did you know one out of every 8 adults in the U. S. has some difficulty hearing even when using a hearing aid? That means that on any given weekend, hundreds of our congregation are missing much of what is being said at Mass. To help them, St. Theresa's has an assistive listening system in the church that can be accessed by wearing compatible headphones (or an earpiece) with a receiver that amplifies the voices heard over the sound system. A neck loop is also available for people who have hearing aids or coch-

lear implants with the telecoil (t-coil) function. These assisted listening devices can be checked out from an usher before Mass. Talk with an usher for more information.


