#### An Act of Mercy for Your Family—Part II

Last week, I introduced the idea that planning for your own funeral and burial, while never a pleasant task, is an act of kindness for your loved ones because it spares them time and effort, and gives them the peace of knowing they are honoring your wishes. This week, I wish to share a few thoughts to help you plan your own funeral Mass.

Objectively speaking, there's not too much to plan. You'll simply need to choose:

Opening hymn
1st reading
Psalm Response (either spoken or sung)
2nd reading
Gospel reading
Offertory hymn
Communion hymn
Closing hymn

The selection of readings and music should be guided by a deep understanding of the purpose of a funeral. Quite simply, the purpose of a funeral is the worship of God, the proclamation of the Gospel, and the celebration of the Eucharist. After we have passed from this life, our greatest hope is the mercy of God. That's why we must take care to plan our funeral Mass to focus not on ourselves, but rather on God, and his mercy.

Furthermore, music at a funeral Mass should not be secular music. Like any liturgy of the Church, the funeral Mass is a prayer. That's why music at a funeral Mass should be liturgical music, also known as sacred music. The simplest definition of sacred music is music written to assist liturgical prayer, whose lyrics are words addressed to God. Too often, people expect that a funeral Mass should be a tribute to the deceased, particularly their personalities and accomplishments. No matter how great a life a person has lived, the grace and mercy of Jesus is our only hope. We need grace, mercy, and lots of prayer.

Please leave written instructions that your personal remembrance should take place either at the vigil the evening before the funeral, or at the graveside afterwards. Those are the two best times to focus on the life of the deceased. The Mass is always first and foremost a prayer, and its focus is always the death and resurrection of Christ, for our salvation. Rooted in such an understanding, choose every reading, every hymn, and every other option at your disposal to two purposes: the praise of God for his mercy, and the request of prayers for the deceased. Every priest is required to prepare the details of his own funeral, so I write all this to you from firsthand experience.

Whenever our hour comes, those who have loved us will be grateful that we made our preparations in advance. This will help them pass through a grieving process made deliberately simpler and less contentious. Christ our Lord loved us, even as sinners, and died for us, but wants us to receive his mercy with a spirit of repentance and readiness. Let's remember that the funeral Mass is meant to help the deceased, and ourselves, get ready to be with all the saints in the heavenly kingdom.

God bless you, and St. Theresa pray for us!


