Be Counter-Cultural. Celebrate Advent.

Each year, two seasons in our Church calendar are virtually un-noticed outside of the Mass: Advent and Christmas. People celebrate the Christmas season of course, but only by replacing Advent. Their celebration begins after Thanksgiving and ends on December 25. Then, just when the joy of the Christmas season is supposed to begin, they put away the carols and the decorations and return to life-as-normal. We're missing something valuable, and it's worth a fight to keep it.

Advent—The Season of Hope: Advent may be the most beautiful season in the entire year because it is uniquely the season of *hope*. There is great joy in a vibrant, living hope that is certain to be fulfilled. That joy is exactly the spirit of Advent. Human beings cannot live without hope. Without it, we surrender to the interior death of despair. Advent reminds us not only what to hope for, but who alone can fulfill that hope. The Old Testament readings we hear throughout the season tell the story of a people whose prayer was for the heart's deepest yearnings—peace, tranquility in the home, a sufficiency of food, an end to suffering, sadness and misery. We know those hopes are partly fulfilled already in the coming of the Messiah, and that the full measure of hope will be filled to overflowing in heaven, to which Christ calls us with no shortage of urgency.

Skip Advent? That's skipping the message of hope! We need the season of Advent because we need time to reflect on this message: our hope will not be disappointed if it is founded on God. Our Heavenly Father answered the prayers of his people by sending Jesus into the world, and he will answer ours as well if we welcome Him into our hearts.

Let's begin to live differently. If Catholics won't celebrate Advent, who will? Let me offer a few simple Advent suggestions that anyone can do:

Own an Advent Wreath: It's fun to light the Advent candles each night at dinnertime. It reminds you of God's presence and His promises. Isn't every meal somehow more peaceful when we light a candle?

Wait for Christmas: Don't decorate right now. Put it off and make it clear that this is the Advent season. Can you put off sending cards until Christmas season? Can you offer a Christmas party during Christmas, instead of during Advent? You might be surprised how much people appreciate it!

Relish the Readings: When you hear Old Testament yearnings for God's promises, remember—hope in Him, and you'll never hope in vain.

God bless you...and St. Theresa, pray for us!
