## A Study of the Angels, Continued: The Cherubim

Let's continue studying about the angels. Since it's been a few months since my last column, let's review. There are nine "choirs" of angels in the celestial hierarchy. An angel "choir" is not a musical group. "Choir" refers to the perfection of an angel's being—essentially, a choir is an angelic rank. Thus far, we've looked at the lowest grouping of the choirs of angels (Principalities, Archangels, Angels), who have direct ministry to human beings. We've also looked at the second grouping of angels (Dominions, Virtues, Powers), who concern themselves with the ordering of material creation. Last time, we looked at the Thrones, from the highest sphere of angels, the direct and immediate servants of God himself. Today, let's look at the second-highest among all the angels, the Cherubim.

Among all heavenly beings, none is mentioned more in the Bible frequently than the Cherubim, and yet their role is never specifically elucidated. The Cherubim guarded the Tree of Life in the Garden of Eden. They adorned the Ark of the Covenant as gold figures spreading their wings over the covering. The Cherubim represent the full domain of God's sovereignty over creation in the Book of Ezekiel, appearing with four different faces: a man (to represent all mankind); an ox (to represent domestic animals); a lion (to represent wild animals); and an eagle (to represent the birds). In the book of Revelation, the task of the Cherubim is to make known the full majesty, power, and holiness of God throughout the Earth.

Classic artwork often depicts the Cherubim with the face of an infant, but this derives from a semantic error. The term "cherub" is similar to the Hebrew word *kerub*, meaning "youth," and so the Cherubim were imagined to be very young. "Cherub," however, actually derives from an Assyrian word which means "near," and thus the Cherubim were named for their closeness to God. The "closeness" of the Cherubim to God led St. Thomas Aquinas to theorize that Lucifer, the fallen angel who became known as satan, was once a Cherub. St. Augustine expounds upon this same idea:

Cherubim means the "Seat of the Glory of God" and is interpreted: "Fullness of Knowledge." Though we realize that Cherubim are exalted heavenly powers and virtues; yet if you will, you too will be one of the Cherubim. For if cherubim means "Seat of God," remember what the Scripture says: "The soul of the just is the Seat of Wisdom." (commentary on Ps. 49)

Please remember that the study of mysterious things, such as God and the angels, requires of us an ample measure of humility. There's very little we can know for sure, and so much that will remain a mystery. One day, please God, we will know the angels as our personal friends and companions in God's presence in heaven.

## **Baptisms**

Parents desiring Baptism for their child must attend a class (preferably before the child's birth) held the first Thursday of each month at 7:30pm in a Conference Room in the Administration Bldg. You may schedule your child for the Sacrament of Baptism (held all Sundays 1:30pm) by visiting the Parish website under Faith, Sacraments, Baptism. Date is confirmed once all paperwork is received in the office (at least 2 weeks prior to the date of desired Baptism.)

## **Matrimony**

The priest must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.


