A Season in Two

Did you know Advent is the only season of the year with two distinct parts? Unlike Lent or Easter, Advent has a first section (from the first Sunday of Advent until December 16) and a second section (December 17 – 24). In the first part of Advent, we focus on the coming of Christ at the end of time. In the second part, which begins today, we focus on the coming of Christ as a child in Bethlehem. Here's an interesting tidbit about this focus taken from the Evening Prayer the Church offers in these last seven days.

Everyone knows the Advent hymn, "O Come, O Come Emmanuel." The seven verses of this hymn come from the seven titles of the Messiah from the book of the prophet Isaiah: Wisdom of God, Lord of Might, King of the Nations, Key of David, Dayspring, Root of Jesse, and Emmanuel. These seven titles are also used at Vespers (the Evening Prayer of the Liturgy of the Hours) each evening here in the last week of Advent.

Each evening, from December 17 – 24, the Church uses a different title as an antiphon. These are known as the "O Antiphons." In an ancient tradition of uncertain origin, Benedictine monks carefully arranged these seven antiphons for a definite purpose. If one starts with the last title and takes the first letter of each, they form a message. The titles (in Latin) are: *Emmanuel, Radix Jesse* (Root of Jesse), *Oriens* (Dayspring), *Clavis David* (Key of David), *Rex Gentium* (King of the Nations), *Adonai* (Lord), *Sapintia* (Wisdom),

The first letter of each title creates an acrostic which is complete on the evening of December 23rd. The letters spell *Ero cras* which, in Latin, means "Tomorrow, I will come." This beautiful tradition culminates four weeks of prayer and preparation for the Christmas season.

What Time is Midnight Mass?

Christmas Eve is funny this year, since Christmas falls on a Monday. Yes, both Sunday and Christmas Day are obligatory, and our Sunday schedule will be odd. We have our ordinary slate of morning Masses, (7:30am; 8:45am; 10:30am) but there will be no 12:30pm Mass on Sunday, December 24. Why no 12:30pm Mass? Because Christmas Eve Masses begin that very afternoon. On Christmas Eve, our schedule will be as it always has—4:00pm, 6:00pm, 8:00pm, and 10:00pm. (What time is Midnight Mass? At St. Theresa, it's 10:00pm!) Christmas Day will also follow the usual Christmas Day schedule—8:00pm, 10:00am, and 12:00pm. I hope you have a prayerful and holy final week of Advent. For all who are traveling, I offer my prayers for your safety, and wish you a beautiful and holy Christmas.

God bless you...and St. Theresa, pray for us!




