Beat Procrastination In 120 Seconds

I usually write on spiritual topics, but this week I would like to share something I learned recently that helped me tremendously. It's a procrastination-beating trick called the "two-minute rule," and it can help you develop good habits, quickly.

Is your life riddled with procrastination? Do you regularly put off annoying tasks—have an inbox full of unanswered messages, an overfilled trashcan, laundry in the washer, and dirty dishes rotting in the sink? Most of the things we put off are more annoying than difficult, yet when they add up, they can be overwhelming. The two-minute rule will help you beat procrastination by tricking your mind into getting things done. It's best understood in two parts.

The Two-Minute Rule, Part I

The first part of the two-minute rule is to recognize that most procrastinated tasks actually take less than two minutes to accomplish. Time it for yourself and see. How long does it take to take out the trash? To empty the dishwasher? To shoot back an email? To pick up the extra clutter? Two minutes or less! The first part of the rule is—if it takes two minutes to do, just do it now.

The Two-Minute Rule, Part II

The second part of the two-minute rule is to tell yourself to work on something for just two minutes. Very often, that will make you want to keep doing it for longer. Do you want to get more exercise? Do you want to spend more time reading and less time on the computer? Do you want to get your homework done or your paper written? Tell yourself that you will work on it for two minutes. Sir Isaac Newton's First Law of Motion tells us that objects at rest tend to stay at rest, and objects in motion tend to remain in motion. This is the physics of human behavior as well. Once we begin doing something, we are inclined to continue. The second part of the two-minute rule says, "Don't put it off—just give it two minutes." Once you get started, you'll be amazed how often you keep going.

I had an old spiritual director who told me, "Do the things now that you'll thank yourself for this evening." That's the attitude that beats procrastination. Are you tired of uncompleted tasks hanging over your head and weighing down your day? Try the two-minute rule. Give your tasks 120 seconds, and take control of your life again. Ready? Set? Go!




