How Skipping Mass Hurts Kids

First communion is a beautiful celebration that ought to be remembered for years. For many children, it is the beginning of a new depth of union with Jesus and a lifetime of strong Christian discipleship, but sadly, many parents prevent this from happening by failing to bring their children to Mass. Not only does this reduce first communion to a cute rite of passage, but failing to attend Mass has terrible long-term consequences for the lives of young people.

A Self-Centered Adulthood

By failing to bring children to Mass, parents fail to teach children a very important message: being an adult means being accountable to something greater than myself. The "something greater" of course is God. It is important for young people to know that adulthood does not mean boundless autonomy. We all must answer to an employer, or to the law, or to the needs of a child or a spouse, or a parish. A mature adult knows that many things take precedence over his own wishes, but when children are taught that soccer, or softball, or a weekend trip are excusing factors from our obligation to God and to one another, it is any surprise if they grow up to believe that their own wishes are more important than anything else, or anyone else? When Mom and Dad teach that Sunday Mass is the highest priority of all activities, they teach them that there is always something greater than ourselves, which principle is the taproot of personal integrity.

A Disregard for Rules, in General

We have failed to emphasize that attending Mass on Sundays and on Holy Days is serious matter, and that serious matter—together with sufficient reflection and full consent of the will—constitute a mortal sin. When a child is taught that this does not really apply, because certainly "God understands" how busy a weekend can be, is it any surprise that young people begin to rationalize away other rules in life, including those that parents have articulated to them? If God's will is negotiable in the name of convenience, by what authority can anyone be held accountable, when his wishes are more convenient than someone else's rule? Should we be surprised when laws or school rules are set aside as well?

A Disrespect for Legitimate Authority

When children see disagreement in the principles of their adult authority figures, they learn to distrust any source of authority in their lives. If a child learns in Catholic school or Religious Education that Mass is important, then learns the opposite at home when parents tell them to just "go with the flow" because they are taking a break from church for the summer, he matures wondering how all the adults in his life have come to disagree so much, and loses confidence in all of them, parents included. When parents send the message that religious teachers are wrong with regard to the importance of Mass, children wonder which other adults in their lives are also wrong, and on how many different subjects? Authority is meant to help young people successfully navigate the many dangers in the world, and to grow up strong, well-grounded adults. Conflicting messages about the importance of Mass, the most important activity of all others in the week, undermines every other message about what is important and what is not.

I hope it is clear that Mass is important, both for children and for parents. Most importantly for all of us, it is the means by which God gives us his grace—his very life—which in the end, is the only thing that matters.

Sacraments

Sponsor Certificates

Please contact the Parish Office to obtain a sponsor certificate prior to a Baptism or Confirmation.

Baptisms

Parents desiring Baptism for their child must attend a class (preferably before the child's birth) held the first Thursday of each month at 7pm (note the time change) in a Conference Room in the Administration Bldg. You may schedule your child for the Sacrament of Baptism (held all Sundays 1:30pm) by visiting the Parish website under Faith, Sacraments, Baptism. Date is confirmed once all paperwork is received in the office (at least 2 weeks prior to the date of desired Baptism.)

Matrimony

The priest must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.

Visit the Parish Website under Faith, Sacraments, Marriage and fill out the Marriage Preparation Questionnaire prior to contacting the Parish Office. A priest will contact you.

RCIA




