#### The Daily Devotions of the Week-Wednesday

Just as each month of the year is traditionally devoted to one single aspect of our Catholic faith, so too is each day of the week. On Wednesdays, we remember St. Joseph. Most everyone knows about the holiness of the Blessed Virgin Mary. She outshines all the other saints in heaven just as the full moon outshines the stars. But have you ever considered that St. Joseph—chosen by God to be the spouse of the Blessed Mother—must have had a degree of sanctity comparable with hers? Remember that marriage takes place between equals. How close to God St. Joseph must be! Furthermore, St. Joseph has a special role in guarding and protecting the Church, and all of us who are in it. Just as St. Joseph was the guardian and protector of Jesus in his earthly life, so too does St. Joseph continue to protect Christ's Mystical Body, his Church.

St. Joseph is the patron saint of fathers, of families, of workers, of expectant mothers, of travelers, and perhaps most importantly, he is the patron saint of a happy death—because he died in the presence of both Jesus and Mary. We ought to allow St. Joseph to become a part of our regular spiritual life, and one of the best ways to do it is to add a St. Joseph devotional prayer each week on Wednesday. Here are a few prayers you may wish to offer:

#### Prayer to St. Joseph for the Grace of a Happy Death:

O Glorious St. Joseph, I choose thee today for my special patron in life and at the hour of my death. Preserve and increase in me the spirit of prayer and fervor in the service of God. Remove far from me every kind of sin; obtain for me that my death may not come upon me unawares, but that I may have time to confess my sins sacramentally and to repent of them with a most perfect understanding and a most sincere and perfect contrition, in order that I may breathe forth my soul in the hands of Jesus and Mary. Amen.

#### Prayer to St. Joseph for the Conversion of a Loved One:

O glorious St. Joseph, who merited to be called 'just' by the Holy Ghost, I urgently recommend to thee the soul of (N.), which Jesus redeemed at the price of His Precious Blood. Thou knowest how deplorable is the state and how unhappy the life of those who have banished this loving Savior from their hearts, and how greatly they are exposed to the danger of losing Him eternally. Permit not, I beseech thee, that a soul so dear to me should continue any longer in its evil ways; preserve it from the danger that threatens it; touch the heart of this prodigal child and conduct him back to the heart of the fondest of Fathers. Abandon him not, I implore thee, till thou hast opened to him the gates of the heavenly city, where he will praise and bless thee throughout eternity for the happiness which he will owe to thy powerful intercession. Amen.

#### Pope Leo XIII's Prayer to St. Joseph:

To you, O blessed Joseph, do we come in our tribulation, and having implored the help of your most holy Spouse, we confidently invoke your patronage also. Through that charity which bound you to the Immaculate Virgin Mother of God and through the paternal love with which you embraced the Child Jesus, we humbly beg you graciously to regard the inheritance which Jesus Christ has purchased by his Blood, and with your power and strength to aid us in our necessities.

O most watchful guardian of the Holy Family, defend the chosen children of Jesus Christ; O most loving father, ward off from us every contagion of error and corrupting influence; O our most mighty protector, be kind to us and from heaven assist us in our struggle with the power of darkness. As once you rescued the Child Jesus from deadly peril, so now protect God's Holy Church from the snares of the enemy and from all adversity; shield, too, each one of us by your constant protection, so that, supported by your example and your aid, we may be able to live piously, to die in holiness, and to obtain eternal happiness in heaven. Amen.






