Pope Francis and The Eucharistic Miracle of Buenos Aires

One of the most important teachings of the Catholic faith is also one of the most difficult to believe—that Jesus Christ is actually present in the Eucharist. God recognizes that many of us need help to believe, and from time to time, provides clear evidence in extraordinary miracles to assist our faith. One such miracle took place in 1996 in a church in Buenos Aires, Argentina, where Jorge Mario Bergoglio, our current Pope Francis, was auxiliary bishop. Here's the story of what happened:

On the evening of August 18, 1996, Fr. Alejandro Pezet found a consecrated host, discarded, and left on the floor of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Buenos Aires. As is the custom, he placed the host in a container of water to allow it to dissolve, and placed the container in the tabernacle. The next morning, to his amazement, Fr. Pezet discovered not a dissolved host, but a bloody substance several times larger than the original host. He informed Bishop Bergoglio, who ordered that the host be photographed and scientifically analyzed. However, three years elapsed before the study began. A professor at a local university, Dr. Ricardo Castañon, a neurophysiologist, was given permission to test the substance, which he brought to New York for analysis. Since he did not wish to prejudice the study, he purposefully did not inform the scientists of where the sample came from.

Dr. Frederick Zugibe, a well-known cardiologist and forensic pathologist, was the scientist who analyzed the host. He determined that the substance was human flesh and blood. Looking at the host through his microscope he said,

I can tell you exactly what this is. This is flesh from the heart muscle, taken from the wall of the left ventricle. It's the muscle that gives the heart its beat and the body its life. I can see white blood cells infiltrated throughout this tissue. This tells me two things: that this heart was living at the moment this sample was taken (because white blood cells die outside of a living organism) and also, since these white blood cells address injury, that this heart has suffered. This is the sort of thing I see in patients who have been beaten about the chest.

Dr. Castañon asked, "How long would these white blood cells have been kept alive if they had come from a piece of human tissue which had been kept in water?" "They would have ceased to exist in a matter of minutes," Dr. Zugibe replied. Dr. Castañon then revealed that the sample had first been kept in a container of distilled water for more than three years. Dr. Zugibe was at a loss to account for this fact. "There is no way to explain it scientifically," he stated.

Dr. Castañon then had the lab reports from New York compared to the lab reports from a much more famous Eucharistic miracle from Lanciano, Italy, taken nearly thirty years earlier. The lab comparison concluded that he two samples must have originated from the same person—an adult male from the Middle East, who has an AB+ blood type. Dr. Castañon, himself a staunch atheist, converted to Catholicism as a consequence of these events.

I pray that learning about this Eucharistic miracle will deepen your faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, and that he will nourish you more deeply than ever.

God bless you, and St. Theresa, pray for us!






