Five Terms for Mercy

Biblical Hebrew is a language with a very limited vocabulary. It has only 5,000 to 6,000 words. Modern English, by contrast easily has 100,000 words in common usage, and by some estimates has a total vocabulary of more than 600,000 words. And yet with only a small percentage of the vocabulary of a modern language, the Hebrew Old Testament has five different words, all of which we translate as "mercy." Let's take a look at each, to deepen our own understanding of what "God's mercy" means.

Hesed: "Hesed" is the most common and most important Old Testament term which we translate to English as "mercy." The central meaning of the word "Hesed" is the act of bestowing kindness, mercy, or forgiveness—which is not deserved. To understand "Hesed," think of the Parable of the Prodigal Son. The Prodigal's behavior towards his good Father was reckless, mercenary, self-centered, and disgraceful. There was never a son less deserving of mercy, and yet boundless mercy is what he was shown. That's the meaning of "Hesed." God's mercy is not unjust. Mercy is love that goes beyond strict justice.

Anim: "Anim" is a Hebrew verb which means, "to bestow favors graciously." To understand "Anim," think of the story of Cinderella. Remember how Cinderella sat by fireplace, forgotten by her family, covered in dirt and dressed in rags, when suddenly and majestically, she was elevated to the level of royalty? That's "Anim." Through the prophet Jeremiah, God speaks to the Israelite people using similar imagery. "Although your wounds are incurable, and your injury beyond healing...I will restore you to health, make you my espoused, and remember your sins no more" (Jer 31). "Anim" shows us the meaning of mercy, in God's generous measure.

Rahamin: "Rahamin" is a term for mercy that makes reference to the love that a mother bestows upon a newborn child. We all know that an infant can't possibly deserve a mother's love and affection, and yet a mother's love for her child is boundless. It reaches to the marrow of her bones. Furthermore, she loves her baby simply because he or she is her very own. God wishes to communicate something of that reality to us in his inspired word, in the Old Testament. Try not to overanalyze God's mercy. There's a quality about it which defies language, logic, or description.

Senechah: "Senechah" means "mercy in the name of righteousness." Many times, in the Old Testament, God says, "I will be merciful to my people because of my Holy Name." This is "Senechah." It means, "I will show mercy to my people, because that is who I am." St. Paul once said to Timothy, "if we are unfaithful, God will still remain faithful, because he cannot deny himself' (2 Tim 2:13). It's a comfort to know that God has revealed his mercy to be inextricable from his very being.

Emet: The Hebrew word "Emet" means "mercy" that is as stable as the ground you stand on. It's simply always there an ever-present reality. In the scriptures, "Emet" is often written together with "Hesed," to remind us that the mercy we do not deserve is always on offer, provided that we repent from all wrongdoing, and turn resolutely back to God and his commandments.

Misericordia: Lastly, a word in Latin, rather than in Hebrew. "Misericordia" has a beautiful etymology, and deserves to be mentioned. Misericordia is a portmanteau of two other Latin words, "Miseria," and "Cor." "Miseria" is the root of our word misery, and means suffering and pain. "Cor" is the Latin word for heart. "Miseria" + "cor" is to embrace the pain of someone else and draw it to your heart, as though it were your own, just like Jesus did for us. That's the meaning of the word mercy. I hope these Biblical terms for mercy help broaden your appreciation of the mercy God offers to us, and the mercy he asks us to offer to one another.
