A Reflection for Troubled Times

The solution to every spiritual pitfall is to re-focus your eyes on the gaze of Christ, who has never taken his eyes off you. Remember this passage from the Gospel of Matthew?

Then he made the disciples get into the boat and precede him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds. After doing so, he went up on the mountain by himself to pray. When it was evening, he was there alone. Meanwhile the boat, already a few miles offshore, was being tossed about by the waves, for the wind was against it. During the fourth watch of the night, he came toward them, walking on the sea. When the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were terrified. "It is a ghost," they said, and they cried out in fear. At once Jesus spoke to them, "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." Peter said to him in reply, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water." He said, "Come." Peter got out of the boat and began to walk on the water toward Jesus. But when he saw how strong the wind was, he became frightened; and, beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus stretched out his hand and caught him, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" After they got into the boat, the wind died down. Those who were in the boat did him homage, saying, "Truly, you are the Son of God." (Mt 14:22-33)

In the storm on the sea, everything went well for St. Peter so long as he fixed his gaze on Christ. He even walked on water. So it will be for each of us, regardless of the storm we are living in. Moreover, you'll become a blessing to others. Your effect will be as the Psalmist describes, "As they go through the bitter valley, they make it a place of springs. They walk with ever growing strength." (Ps. 84)

With this in mind, pray over this meditation from St. John Henry Cardinal Newman. He finds solace in every imaginable circumstance by returning his gaze to Christ, and away from himself and his own woes. If we do the same, we will find peace and become a source of blessing, regardless of our hardships.

"God has created me to do Him some definite service. He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another. I have my mission. I may never know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next. I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection between persons. He has not created me for naught. I shall do good; I shall do His work. I shall be an angel of peace, a preacher of truth in my own place, while not intending it if I do but keep His commandments. Therefore, I will trust Him, whatever I am, I can never be thrown away. If I am in sickness, my sickness may serve Him, in perplexity, my perplexity may serve Him. If I am in sorrow, my sorrow may serve Him. He does nothing in vain. He knows what He is about. He may take away my friends. He may throw me among strangers. He may make me feel desolate, make my spirits sink, hide my future from me. Still, He knows what He is about." (St. JHC Newman)

Because we failed to turn out the pro-life vote in November of 2023, when every seat in the Virginia General Assembly was on the ballot, we currently have an extremely pro-abortion majority in both the House of Delegates and the Senate which is fast-tracking this dangerous resolution.

This amendment is out of step with the values of a majority of Virginians. It goes far beyond what Roe v. Wade allowed.

Amendment Process

First Session - January 2025

The amendment has to be approved by both legislative chambers. The Governor cannot veto an amendment.

- November 2025 Election
 - A general election must occur before the amendment is taken up in the next session. On Tuesday, November 4th we have an opportunity to return a pro-life majority to the Virginia House of Delegates. *Are you registered to vote?*
- **2** Second Session January 2026
 - The amendment is introduced for the second time and must pass both chambers with unaltered language. A pro-life majority of delegates would stop the amendment at this juncture.
 - November 2026 Ballot Initiative

The amendment, as passed twice, goes to the ballot for the people to vote "yes" or "no" to amend the Constitution.

- Parental consent laws: Eliminated.
- Abortions up to birth: Guaranteed.
- Religious liberty: Denied.
- Health of women and girls: At risk.
- Taxpayers: Forced to fund abortion.
- Predators:
 Protected.

This amendment could turn Virginia into the abortion destination of the South.


