Time Is a Mystery

What is time? What exactly happens in the passing of a single second that puts one moment in the past and another moment in the present? You might think you know what "time" is, until you take a moment to think about it. St. Augustine once said, "if no one asks me, I know what time is. If I want to explain time to an inquirer, I do not know what it is!" The nature of time is a philosophical mystery that has always fascinated me. Some say time is a measure of change, but that doesn't make any sense, since change does not occur at a steady pace at all. Some say time is a way of measuring distance travelled along the space-time continuum, but as any high-school physics student can tell you, the experience of that distance is relative from one traveler to the next.

The ancient Greeks expressed the mystery of time with three different words: "Chronos," "Kairos," and "Aeon." "Chronos" marks the passing of objective, measured time. Chronos means the days, months, and years of the calendar—or the hours, minutes, and seconds of the clock. Chronos is what you experience when you're sitting in your dentist's chair nervously awaiting his drill, or as you're lodged helplessly in traffic, watching the minutes tick by, one by one.

"Kairos," by contrast, is subjective time. Kairos is when you experience an hour as if it were a minute, or a minute as if it were an hour. Kairos is what we experience on vacation when we forget to count the hours, or when we're catching up in conversation with an old friend we have not spoken with in years. Kairos is what we experience in prayer (hopefully!), whether at Mass or on our own.

Finally, "Aeon" is the Greek term for eternity. By the word Aeon, the ancients captured perfectly a concept which expresses our own Christian theology of time as experienced in heaven. (Theologians and Christian writers describe the concept of "time" in heaven with the word "aeviternity." Aeviternity is a state of being between the eternity of God and the temporal existence of this world. Although it is not the same as God's eternity, the idea of "time" in heaven will be free from death, decay, or annihilation.) The Greek term "Aeon" means the past, the present, and the future, all experienced at once as if they were one single reality.

You don't have to wait until heaven to capture an experience of Aeon. That's because, even though you can only experience one single moment at a time, your soul remains the sum total of all you have ever been. There's more to "you" than any single moment of time can capture. This explains why we love nostalgia, or why a memory re-lived can move us so deeply. It's a small experience of "Aeon," and a little sliver of the mystery of heaven.

Chronos, Kairos, and Aeon all express different aspects of God's will for our lives. Chronos corresponds to our duty to work. Kairos corresponds to our relationships to others. Aeon expresses our ultimate reality, which is our eternal relationship to God. As one moment passes away and a new moment begins, let's not forget that regardless of what "time" is, our time on Earth is limited and incalculably precious.




