#### Now That Lent is Over...

Here's a topic I have meant to address for a long time. Are Catholics required to do penance on Fridays? Most-everyone knows that Fridays in Lent are days of penance, (we are supposed to go "meatless" on Lenten Fridays as a common act of penance) but are we obliged to practice any particular penance on the other Fridays of the year? Elders among us will remember a time when every Friday was meatless, both during Lent and afterwards, but one day back in the 1960s, that penance suddenly vanished. Did anything ever replace it?

Let's take a closer look at what happened. The year was 1966. The Second Vatican Council had just ended, and confusion ran high as to what Vatican II would mean, practically speaking, in the lives of Catholics throughout the world. Some said Vatican II had gone "too far," and others said "it had not gone far enough." At this time the bishops of the United States, operating under the authority given them in the Code of Canon Law, voted to amend the "meatless Friday" penance which had been a benchmark of Catholic living for centuries.

After much debate, the U.S. bishops maintained "meatless Fridays" for Lent, but voted to allow each individual to substitute his own penance for the other Fridays of the year. Here's a quick look at their original words:

Friday itself remains a special day of penitential observance throughout the year. [Friday] should be, in each week, something of what Lent is in the entire year. Even though we hereby terminate the traditional law of abstinence [going meatless] as binding under pain of sin, [Catholics should still] freely make of every Friday a day of works of voluntary self-denial and personal penance in prayerful remembrance of the passion of Jesus Christ.

So if the meatless law was taken away, what obligation, if any, did the bishops put in its place? If we understand the term "obligation" properly, we must admit that no obligation was put in its place. The bishops "strongly urged" all Catholics to continue to give up meat on Fridays, but in the language of Church documents, "strongly urged" does not mean "morally bound." This created an entirely predictable problem. It left Catholics with the impression that Friday is the same as every other day of the week, although that was never the intention of the Church.

What should we do with Fridays? Consider the statement that Friday "should be, in each week, something of what Lent is." Lent is a special time of penance to unite ourselves with Jesus Christ crucified. Although there is no "obligation" to do something specific on Friday, it should be a time in which we try to keep the spirit of Lent. There should be some special attention to prayer, self-denial, and works of charity, but it is up to you to choose what they are. Most bishops thought that Catholics would continue to abstain from meat on Fridays. That is why, of all the possible penances we could choose, abstinence from meat should be high on the list.

Is Friday still a special day of penance? Yes, it is. As we continue the year, let's think of ways to make Friday a special day dedicated to Jesus, especially in his suffering and death.

#### **Beneath The Surface**

Mini Reflection: It does sound unbelievable, the story of the Resurrection. But lots of things are unbelievable. That doesn't mean they're not true. Take Thomas' example: stay close to the people you trust. Be willing to recognize Jesus when he's in front of you.

#### Wonder, Don't Wander

My daughter recently asked me if it's okay to "wonder if all the Jesus stuff is true."

I wasn't surprised by her question. I've expected it, in fact. If you're raising a child to be a critical thinker, you don't want them to accept everything you tell them simply because it comes from your lips. I have promised my

children that I will always give them the truth about God. But that's all I can do — give it to them. Whether or not they accept it, ultimately, is their own choice.

"I know it's true," she told me. "But sometimes it just all sounds so... unbelievable."

She's not wrong. It does sound unbelievable that an all-powerful God could create us for no reason other than sheer love, that He could be generous enough to give us free will to accept that love, that he could be merciful enough not to destroy us when we reject that love, and finally that he could be faithful enough in that love to become flesh and die in order to save us from the consequences of our own poor choices.

But lots of things are unbelievable. That doesn't mean they're not true.

When Jesus says, "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed," he isn't calling Thomas a fool for questioning something that sounds a little outrageous. He's just highlighting the fact that Thomas is afforded a luxury that none of the Christians born after him, my daughter included, will have: he gets to see proof with his own eyes.

I told my daughter it's fine to wonder — just don't wander. Take Thomas' example. Stay close to the people you trust. Return to the warmth of the upper room. Be willing to recognize Jesus when he's in front of you. Never be afraid to believe.




