I Am Embarrassed to Admit It...But I Do Not Know How to Pray!

Many people say, "I do not know how to pray," because they fail to realize that they have already done it many times before. -Fr. Thomas Dubau

You have been praying all your life, sometimes when you did not even realize it. Prayer happens when you learn that a friend or family member has been hurt in an accident. Prayer happens the moment a student hears the words, "pop quiz today!" Prayer happens whenever things seem out of control, and your inner spirit spontaneously wells up as if to say, "God come and help me!" That's because prayer is simply the lifting of your mind and heart to God.

By "mind," I mean your attention, and by "heart," I mean your free will. As disciples of Christ though, we should pray not only in moments of emergency, but as a daily habit. Prayer is our relationship with God, and relationships die without regular communication. How do we pray? We offer God the very same "mind and heart" on a regular, daily basis that we have usually reserved for an hour of crisis.

Mother Teresa once said, "prayer is a dialogue, both sides speaking, both sides listening." What is on your heart at the moment—worries, concerns, relationships, anxieties, fears? Just bring them all to God. God already knows them, of course, but God can transform them when we bring them into his presence. Just as sunlight melts the snow, so too does God's presence transform our concerns and worries. The deeper your prayer, the deeper the work of God's transformation.

To begin to pray, just place yourself in God's presence. This will require time and stillness. You will need to create that time and stillness deliberately by finding a quiet place or a quiet time that makes prayer possible. Set aside a segment of time, even as little as ten or fifteen minutes, and persevere through it, even when you feel nothing is happening.

Now, to "listen" to God, you will often need to read scripture. Find a passage that you already like and understand. Don't choose something confusing. Think about your problem in light of the passage, and begin to hear the voice of God. A sort of dialogue now begins. When your mind "drifts off" in distraction, just go back to the text again, with no worries. Prayer is like planting a seed. It seems very small. It seems like nothing has happened, and it does not grow overnight. With perseverance though, there will be big changes. Changes in your life too big to ignore or dismiss.

You see, you already know how to pray. Now you simply need to be dedicated to making it part of each day. We will talk about how to do that, next week.

God bless you...and St. Theresa, pray for us!



Pro-Life Corner

What you should know about the extreme abortion amendment to the Virginia Constitution. Part 5

In Parts 4 & 5 of this series, we've talked about what is meant by "every individual" in this proposed amendment. What is not discussed is, if there is a right to reproductive freedom, who will pay for it. Medical procedures and therapies aren't free. Abortions, transition surgeries, hor-

mone therapy, etc are not free. Those who perform the procedures, prescribe the drugs, and/or offer the counselling will expect to be paid. Although the bill's proponents may say insurance will pay for it, how will that work? Of course, we all know, that means we will all be footing the bill as the cost of our insurance policies increase, whether we agree with the policy or not. Again, Coloradans are facing the same kind of pressure to pay for such

procedures. These include operations which fall under the definition of cosmetic surgery. So, think of this scenario: women who have had mastectomies due to cancer often have to pay for their own reconstruction surgery, while a young man who wants to look like a woman would not have to pay for the same procedure. 
