The Annunciation: An Evening Examination of Conscience

Most of us know about an examination of conscience from going to confession. Perhaps you've looked at such an examination—a list of sins, based on the Ten Commandments—to help you remember all the things you need to confess. But did you know that our Church has a centuries-old spiritual tradition of examining your conscience each day before sleep? It's much more than a preparation for confession. It's an essential part of a healthy spiritual life. If your only knowledge of an examination of conscience has been negative—acknowledging your sins and failings—then you've really missed out. Take a look at this simple, brief evening examination of conscience, based on the Annunciation (Luke 1: 26-38). Begin by reading the passage, then consider...

• God Sent Gabriel to Mary with a Message of Good News
God has allowed each person into your life today for a purpose. There are no coincidences.
Someone came into your life today with a message to help you.
Who affected you most today? What is God trying to tell you through that person?

• Gabriel Said to Mary, "The Lord is with you"
God has been present to you all day. Have you been present to him?
Have you forgotten his presence and spent the day anxious? Worried?
Offer it all to God, and tomorrow, remember his power over all things.
Ask God for the grace to replace your fear with the peace of his presence.

• Gabriel Said to Mary, "Do Not Be Afraid."

Fear is nature's way of protecting you from danger, but in your spiritual life, it is almost always an indication of a lack of trust in God's goodness. God wants to call you closer, but cannot as long as fear remains. What are you clinging to that prevents you from drawing closer to God? Ask for the grace to believe that his will is better than yours. Ask for the grace to place it in his hands.

• Gabriel Said to Mary, "You Have Found Favor with God"

Now is the time to acknowledge any sins you have committed today. Unlike the Blessed Virgin Mary, we often act in a way unbecoming of a son or daughter of God. How have I acted in a way that would sadden the heart of Christ? Which are the sins I am sorry for, and which I ask for God to help me avoid tomorrow?

• Gabriel Said to Mary, "The Holy Spirit Will Come Upon You"

The Holy Spirit is like the spark that ignites a fire, or the wind that fills a sail. Many pieces of our lives can be in perfect place, but without life of the Holy Spirit, coming from outside of us, we will never be who God made us to be. The Holy Spirit often surprises us, arriving when we least expect. How have I resisted the power of the Holy Spirit today? How can I do better?

• Gabriel Said to Mary, "Nothing is Impossible for God"

God makes the greatest saints of the worst sinners, turns the defeat of Calvary into the victory of Easter, and transforms even the most hardened hearts. Where have I failed to recognize God's omnipotence today? Have I turned to him in trust, or have I sulked in despair and presumed defeat?

• Mary said, "Let it be Done to Me According to Your Word."

Mary actively wanted God's will, not her own. Does that describe me today?

Mary said "yes" to God before knowing every detail. Do I write God a blank check, like she did?

Mary changed her life to fit God's plan. Do I ask God to change his plan to fit my life?

Mary persevered, even when it was difficult. Do I have the faith to persevere like she did?

God bless you...and St. Theresa, pray for us!


