Who Are Those Saints Behind the Altar?

Occasionally, I am asked about the six saints depicted in the mosaics of the high altar in the center of our church. Let's clear up the confusion, just for fun. These mosaics, on either side of the statue of St. Therese, depict six saints who were inspirational to her. From left to right, these saints are:

- **St. Francis de Sales**: St. Francis de Sales was bishop of Geneva, Switzerland in the days of the Protestant Reformation. He sought to bring souls back to the Church through his personal life and his writings, most notably, the *Introduction to the Devout Life*. St. Francis de Sales is known for the gentleness and tenderness of his demeanor, together with the resolute strength of his faith. With St. Jane Francis de Chantal, he founded the Visitation Order. St. Francis de Sales died in 1622, and is the patron saint of writers, journalists, and the deaf.
- **St. Agnes**: St. Agnes was martyred at the age of twelve. She was the daughter of a wealthy family, and was said to be so beautiful that high-ranking Roman officials tried to win her hand in marriage. Agnes, however, had sworn never to marry. "Jesus Christ is my only Spouse," she had said. One spurned suitor was so insulted at Agnes' refusal to marry him that he submitted her name to the authorities as a Christian. Eyewitness testimony of her beheading under the reign of Roman Emperor Diocletian tells the story of a girl with such charisma and confidence in her faith, that the executioner was afraid to carry out his duty. St. Agnes died in the year 304, and is the patron saint of girls, virgins, and the virtue of chastity.
- **St. Augustine**: St. Augustine was the bishop of Hippo (today, Algeria) in North Africa. He lived a life of serious sin for decades before the sadness of his actions compelled him to discover the love and mercy of God. Augustine was one of the most brilliant minds of his time, and once baptized as a Christian, he used his intellectual gifts to become one of the greatest Christian scholars in history. His writings, including the *Confessions*, and the *City of God*, have inspired countless souls, both Catholic and Protestant, for centuries. St. Augustine died in the year 430, and is the patron saint of theologians, printers, and brewers.
- **St. Mary Magdalene**: St. Mary Magdalene was one of Jesus first followers. She is often assumed to have been a prostitute, but the Gospels do not mention this. They tell us only that Jesus had "delivered her of seven devils" (Lk 8:2), and her ensuing reputation is mere conjecture. She was one of just a few followers who were with Jesus on Calvary when he was crucified, and the Gospels recount that she was the first witness to Jesus' resurrection. St. Mary Magdalene died in the first century, and is the patron saint of converts, repentant sinners, and women.
- **St. Theophane Venard**: St. Theophane Venard was a French missionary to Vietnam who was martyred for the faith under the Vietnamese emperor Minh-Menh. In his time, priests ministered to the people only by night, under cover of darkness. Theophane was betrayed by an enemy, and arrested. During his trail, he refused to renounce his faith, and was condemned to death by beheading. During his final days, he wrote a letter to his family in which he said, "We are all flowers planted on this earth, which God plucks in His own good time. Some sooner, some later." Inspired by this single line, St. Therese began to think of herself as a "little flower" in God's garden. St. Theophane died in 1861.
- **St. Joan of Arc**: St. Joan of Arc was born a peasant in the village of Domremy, near the French province of Lorraine. As a teenager, she received visions of St. Michael the Archangel and St. Catherine of Sienna who told her to drive English armies from French territory in the waning days of the Hundred Years' War (1337-1453). Undaunted by the seeming impossibility of this mission, a seventeen-year-old Joan approached the King of France to obtain his blessing lead his armies in battle. After two failed efforts, Joan won the King's trust and immediately inspired her troops, turning the tide of the war in France's favor. Joan would later be betrayed, and in 1431, was handed over to the English who burned her at the stake, falsely accusing her of heresy. St. Joan of Arc is the patron saint of soldiers, prisoners, and together with St. Theresa, is the patron saint of France.

God bless you, and St. Theresa, pray for us!






