#### Please Help the Josephite Missionaries

The best way to donate to this appeal is by check. Simply make your check payable to St. Theresa, and be sure to put "MCP" in the memo line. That will make sure the funds go to the "Mission Cooperative Plan" this year. You may drop a check in the collection basket, or in the boxes by the exits of church.




