Why Would St. Theresa Install an Altar Rail?

Since I arrived at St. Theresa five years ago, I have noticed a steady and unmistakable behavioral trend among the faithful. Every year, more and more people are choosing to kneel to receive the Eucharist. Moreover, while the number of people kneeling for communion has become larger and larger, the age of those kneeling has become younger and younger. So, it didn't surprise me last year when several parishioners approached me with the request that St. Theresa install an altar rail for the benefit of those who kneel for communion. After consulting with Bishop Burbidge and the Office of Divine Worship, after the architecture firm of O'Brien and Keane concluded that the St. Theresa sanctuary was perfectly suited for an altar rail, and after several anonymous parishioners agreed to pay the full cost for the construction and installation of a rail with designated gifts, I decided that installing an altar rail would be a good idea. (How could anyone object when expenses were paid by private donors?)

There are a few important things to note about the St. Theresa altar rail:

- Bishop Burbidge insists that the faithful know that standing is the normative posture for receiving Holy Communion in the United States. Specifically, "the norm established for the Dioceses of the United States of America is that Holy Communion is to be received standing, unless an individual member of the faithful wishes to receive Communion while kneeling (Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, Instruction, Redemptionis Sacramentum, March 25, 2004, no. 91)." It is for the sake of those who wish to kneel that we install this rail. It does not change the norms established by the Bishops of the United States.
- All of our regular communion stations will remain. There will be no changes or alterations to our regular communion practices. (Elderly and disabled who receive communion in the back of church...those who receive in the choir loft...those who receive at any of our three main communion lines...will continue to do so, as always.) This new rail will simply add a new option to receive communion. It will make communion far less cumbersome. Those who kneel to receive will not interrupt the communion line if they ever struggle to kneel and get themselves back up again. Everyone will benefit from that.
- Yes, you may approach the rail standing, if you wish. There is no obligation to kneel. You may also approach the rail to receive on the hand. There is no obligation to receive on the tongue. But regardless of how you receive communion, please remember to do so reverently and with great care. The Eucharist, as your priests have reminded you many times, is Jesus himself. The sacredness of the moment of receiving communion therefore cannot be overestimated.
- How long will the installation take? I am told that it will all happen within the span of one working week, so it should not disrupt our Sunday schedule at all.

Lastly, for the sake of those who have never seen an altar rail before: how exactly does one receive communion from an altar rail? The answer is simple—just approach the rail from behind, find an open spot at the rail, kneel down there (or stand if you wish), and wait for a priest to bring communion to you. Your manner of receiving communion will be exactly the same. The priest will say "The Body of Christ," and your reply will be, "Amen." After you have received communion, simply go back to your pew to allow another person to approach the rail, just like you did. The priest will visit everyone who comes to the rail, until there are no more people left waiting for communion.

My personal prediction is that this rail will be very popular. I've seen this happen at other parishes—those who have never received the Eucharist at an altar rail before usually discover that they greatly prefer it. They find it to be much more calm, reverent, and prayerful than standing in line. The rail allows you to have a few extra moments of reverent reflection and intimacy with Christ, as you await in silence for His personal arrival to you.

Next week, I will share our architectural drawings, here in the bulletin. I think you'll agree that the rail will be not only useful and prayerful, but also undeniably beautiful.






