# Why Is the Altar Made of Stone?

Although it's certainly not true in every case, in most Catholic Churches, the altar is usually made of stone. Go to the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in D.C., or to the Cathedral in Arlington, or to St. Peter's in the Vatican, or to any of hundreds of other prominent Catholic churches around the world, and you'll notice that the altar is (almost) always made of stone. But, why is that the case? Why is cold, heavy stone used to link Earth to Heaven? Let's take a closer look.

Stone has always been sacred: Do you remember the meaning of the word "sacred?" It means that which is "set apart" for the worship of God. From the beginning of salvation history, stone was always used to mark the "sacredness" of God's presence on Earth. After the great flood, Noah built an altar made of stone. When God asked Abraham to sacrifice his son Isaac, before he set in place the wood of the sacrifice, he first built an altar of stone. After wrestling with God at Peniel, Jacob built an altar and said, "This stone... shall be God's house," (Gen 28:22). Throughout the Old Testament, Israelite sacrifices were always placed on stone altars rather than wooden tables, because an altar is a place of sacrifice. And because sacrifice is costly, it is placed on that which is firm and permanent, rather than delicate and flimsy. It's why God himself has always directed his servants to use stone as the foundation for proper worship.

Stone Represents Christ: An altar, moreover, is not just where sacrifice is offered to God, it is also a sign of Who is offered. Scripture often refers to Christ in metaphors of stone. Jesus is, "The stone the builders rejected, which has become the cornerstone," (Ps 118:22). "The rock of our salvation," (Ps 95:1). "The spiritual Rock... and the Rock was Christ" (1 Cor 10:4). To St. Peter, who would be his representative on Earth after his ascension into heaven, Jesus said, "upon this rock I will build my Church," (Mt: 16:18). As you may already know the early Christians celebrated the first ever Masses on the tombs of the martyrs—essentially, on a stone table—echoing the burial place of Christ at Golgotha. In Christian worship, stone has always been the fixed point on Earth in which the Body of Christ was held.

**And What of Wooden Altars?** In the Catholic Church, there are two types of altars: fixed altars, and portable altars. A fixed altar must be made of stone, solidly built, and permanently attached to a sanctuary floor. Portable altars, by contrast, are often made of wood, and are intended for use in chapels, and other sacred spaces understood to be temporary. And yet, even a wooden altar must contain a stone slab large enough to hold the Sacred Host and the base of the chalice. This stone slab may be inserted into a wooden altar, but is not consecrated as a stone altar is. Wooden altars are fully valid, and indeed become sacred places, but are intended for those locations where the establishment of a permanent church is not possible. The distinction between fixed altar and a portable altar applies not to their physical "portability," but to their intended permanence.

Wood rots. Cloth fades. But stone endures. That's why the Church builds her altars from stone, as if to say, "the sacrifice of Christ is eternal, and so too is God's presence among his people." In the Catholic faith, even the stone preaches!
