Catholic Charities Christmas Collection

No one likes second collections, but next week's Catholic Charities second collection is perhaps the most important one of the year. Catholic Charities helps people right here in our area every day, and I am deeply grateful for the services they offer. Hardly a week goes by that I do not recommend one of our parishioners to go to Catholic Charities.

The Christmas Collection makes up to 10 percent of Catholic Charities' budget each year. And, because Catholic Charities chooses not to accept government money that would force them to compromise the teachings of our faith, this second collection is all the more crucial. Consider some of these facts. Last year, Catholic Charities:

- Distributed over 2.073 million pounds of food, fulfilling more than 85,000 requests.
- Provided free health care to 2,110 patients who were uninsured, or under-insured.
- Served 25,677 free meals to homeless and hungry individuals and families.
- Enabled more than 1,600 people to pay their rent and avoid eviction.
- Served 353 people with adoption support, and crisis pregnancy support.
- Provided mental health services to more than 830 families.
- Assisted more than 2,000 newly arrived refugees with housing and other necessities
- Served 126 senior citizens with food and other needed care.

In the past year, Catholic Charities has helped more than 100,000 people here in our area. One thing I love about Catholic Charities is that they help women, tempted to abortion, to realize they can choose life. They placed 28 children in loving homes and counseled more than 800 people this past year alone. Many of these people had been abortion-minded women. More than 1,000 people received Catholic counseling services, many of them right here in Ashburn. Catholic Charities also coordinates with other pro-life groups to defend the right to life in the state of Virginia.

I hope you can see that Catholic Charities does a great deal of good. Please consider supporting the second collection next weekend.





Sponsor Certificates

Please contact the Parish Office to obtain a sponsor certificate prior to a Baptism or Confirmation.

Baptisms

Parents desiring Baptism for their child must attend a class (preferably before the child's birth) held the first Thursday of each month at 7pm (note the time change) in a Conference Room in the Administration Bldg. You may schedule your child for the Sacrament of Baptism (held all Sundays 1:30pm) by visiting the Parish website under Faith, Sacraments, Baptism. Date is confirmed once all paperwork is received in the office (at least 2 weeks prior to the date of desired Baptism.)

Matrimony

The priest must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.

Visit the Parish Website under Faith, Sacraments, Marriage and fill out the Marriage Preparation Questionnaire prior to contacting the Parish Office. A priest will contact you.

OCIA




