

## Can I Blame God When Things Are Bad?

If we thank God when things are good, can we blame God when things are bad? It's certainly a tempting thought. After all, it's no different from how we behave towards one another. When I was a little boy, I helped my mother clean the house, vacuum the rugs, and wash the windows. She was so thankful to me for my good will and hard work. Later that day, I played inside the family car, and carelessly left the car windows open overnight, in a rainstorm. Mom blamed me for my negligence—and for very good reason. When God sends us a blessing, it makes sense to praise him. Might we be justified in blaming God when things go wrong?

It's a very reasonable question, but the problem lies in its unstated premise—that God is no different from any other human actor in our day-to-day lives. Unlike human beings, God does nothing thoughtlessly. In God there is no selfishness, laziness, carelessness, pettiness, and certainly nothing of ill-will. Many people “blame” God for what goes wrong—but only because they view God no differently from any other flawed human being. That's not who God is. God is our all-perfect heavenly Father (Mt 5:48). Only with God's perfect goodness as our starting point can we believe that God makes all things work for the good for those who love Him, (Rm 8:28).

St. Paul tells us, “Rejoice always, pray constantly, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you” (1 Th 5: 16-18). At a merely human level, this can seem not only difficult, but impossible. How on Earth can we be expected to rejoice and give thanks, always, and in all circumstances? In times of grief, illness, or depression? Or when God seems absent? Or when sincere prayers seem to fall on deaf ears? How can we give thanks? At such times, what should our attitude toward God be?

It's helpful to distinguish between two ideas—God's “active will,” and God's “permissive will.” By God's “active will,” we mean to indicate those things God would have willed if there had never been sin. By God's “permissive will,” we mean to indicate those things God has allowed, given that his creatures did not listen to his voice. Only in the latter sense does God allow suffering, never the former. Human sinfulness has fragmented God's good creation, and suffering is the consequence. God only allows “bad things” to bring about some greater good. “Where sin increased, grace abounded all the more” (Rm 5:20).

You might be surprised to learn that there is at least one sense at least in which we can “blame” God in a holy way. It's the “cry of the just man,” found in the Psalms. Psalm 34 says, “I will bless the Lord at all times. His praise always on my lips” (Ps 34:1). Interestingly enough, Psalm 34 sees no contradiction between praising God at all times, and crying out to Him in times of distress: “The poor man cried, and the Lord heard him, and saved him from all his distress...The eyes of the Lord are toward the just, and his ears toward their cry...When the just cry for help, the Lord hears him. From all of their troubles, he saves him,” (Ps 34: 6, 15, 17).

“Holy blame” rejects any impulse to deny God's goodness, but allows for that raw but admirable honesty which characterizes so many of the saints. It's good, and Biblical, to “cry out” to God when bad things happen. To tell God that at this moment, we do not sense His goodness, and that his ways make no sense to us. We pay God a compliment by praying with such honesty.

But we must remember, even in our darkest moments, that God is always good, and his ways, while impenetrable to the human mind, are always beautiful. Both God, and our existence, remain fundamentally good even when our life seems filled with sorrows. God uses even the “bad times” to build holiness, patience, humility, and hope for heaven, our true and eternal country. Even in times of trial, let's say with Job from our hearts, “The Lord has given, and the Lord has taken away. Blessed be the name of the Lord” (Job 2:10).

God bless you...and St. Theresa, pray for us!


