## A King and a Jackass

Economics have long played a part in the lowly image given to the humble donkey. Since the days in which donkeys labored with the Israelites when they were enslaved to Pharaoh, the donkey has been the work companion of the underprivileged and marginalized. In 19th century Europe and America, those who couldn't afford a horse rode a donkey. Their shaggy coat, long ears, spindly tail, and outrageous bray have always made it easy for people to poke fun at them. (When I was a boy in Montana, the braying donkey was disdainfully called a "Rocky Mountain Canary"). In Jesus' time, things were no different. The humble donkey was the ordinary tool of simple laborers. The wealthy owned teams of oxen. Nobles rode beautiful horses. But the poor donkey was always like the biological punchline of a divinely-authored joke.

Now, all during his public career, Jesus had sternly resisted when people called him the "Messiah." If ever anyone proclaimed Jesus to be the one the prophets had foretold, Jesus resolutely ordered them to keep silent. When the crowds tried to carry him off to make him King, Jesus quietly slipped away into the night. And yet today, at the beginning of Holy Week, Jesus is willing to accept the title he once tried to silence. He rides triumphantly into Jerusalem—on the back of a humble donkey. Furthermore, the Gospel states that this is not only a donkey, but a foal—a young donkey less than a year old—so young that no one had ever yet ridden upon its back. Not a glistening white stallion, but an inexperienced, young, frail, humble donkey—this is the animal upon which the King of Kings rides into Jerusalem in triumph, in fulfillment of the scriptures.

Behold, Jerusalem—this is not the Messiah you were expecting.

At the beginning of the Palm Sunday Mass, we hear the Gospel passage in which Jesus tells two of his disciples to go into a neighboring town and to find this humble animal. "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find an ass tethered, and a colt with her. Untie them and bring them here to me. And if anyone should say anything to you, reply, 'The master has need of them'" (Mt 21:2-3). Consider—a donkey is a very good image for a faithful disciple of Christ. Our purpose in life is not to draw attention to ourselves, to have a brilliant career, to aggrandize our egos. Our purpose is to serve the Master's need. We cooperate with God's will as he sees fit—to do what he wills, in the way he wills, for as long as he wills, because he wills it.

The humble donkey of Palm Sunday brought Christ to others, in the time and manner that God willed it. No one would have given the animal a moment's notice, except perhaps to chuckle at him. So it must be for us as well. You are not in this place, at this time, with these people by accident. The Master has need of you. Exactly how and why is not ours to know, but it will be revealed to you someday. Until then, our task is to be the very best bearer of Christ that we can be. Most will never notice us. Some might even laugh. If the King calls me to be a jackass in the eyes of others, then God be praised. Because if we are about God's will—if we do as the Master needs us to—we will do more good than we know. The humble donkey of Jerusalem brought the King of the Universe to others. May the same be said of us!

God bless you, and St. Theresa, pray for us!

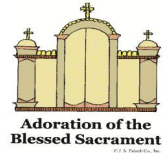

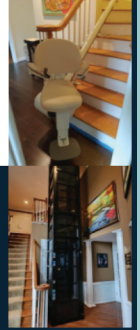
