## A Word from Fr. John

On my first day here, two things occurred that showed me the Lord is always with us and that He is trying to make us Saints in different ways here at St. Theresa's. After my first homily on that Thursday morning four years ago, I had a note waiting in my mailbox. It was a note of appreciation because I talked about prayer warriors and noticed the contemplative side of the parish. I did not know at the time how much there are wonderful prayer warriors all around here. Additionally, as I walked out, I came upon a conversation of some parishioners talking about issues concerning food and things to do to start healing physically. As I talked with them about my own struggles, the Holy Spirit, through them, reassured me that all will be fine here. You will have many people here to help you, reflecting the active part of the Church. Father, we got you covered. Just help us spiritually. We finished our talk about how God has put us together to become Saints and does not leave us to fend for ourselves.

During my four years as a parochial vicar at St. Theresa Parish – and these little stories illustrate the point – I have been treated extraordinarily well by everyone. I want to thank all of the parishioners at St. Theresa's for their support, prayers, generosity, and kindness. This is a holy parish. I am blessed to have called it my home and it will always be my first assignment. Next, I want to thank the parish and school staff, and all the volunteers. It has been an incredible pleasure to work with you all, and to serve the Lord, and this parish in countless ways.

Most of all, however, I want to thank the priests I have served with during my time here. In particular, Fr. Hudgins for being a wonderful first pastor during my assignment over the last four years. I am also grateful to have served with Fr. Barnes, Fr. DeForest, Fr. Dudzinski, and Fr. Vaccaro. Moreover, I have had the privilege to work with three deacons while I have been here: Deacon Paul, Deacon Renzette, and Deacon Noah, who are wonderful servants, and were ready to help in any way when called upon.

Yet, I also have to reflect on my sins and failings. Being a priest is a great gift but a tremendous responsibility. For the times I did it well, with the help of God's grace, I am thankful and I ask for forgiveness for the times that I failed out of human weakness. I am truly sorry for not serving with even more holiness and zeal with you all.

Again, with this being my first assignment, I carry with me so much of you and this parish, including the adoration chapel, house blessings, the pancake breakfasts and donut Sundays, the prayer groups and festival of trees and many school and religious education activities that I will miss greatly. I had much great joy with all of the Sacraments I could celebrate as an instrument of God's grace – bringing Jesus to Mass, confessions, Baptisms, Marriages, anointings of the sick, and funerals.

I will always keep you in my prayers as I head down Route 28 to begin my new assignment at St. Andrew's in Clifton as a parochial vicar. Please pray for Fr. Alex Solsma who will begin his assignment here replacing me. He is a friend with a lot of energy, so I think he will fit in without any trouble. In closing, I would appreciate very much any prayers you might offer for me and those who I will be getting to know at my new parish and whom now I will be asking for some food assistance 😊
