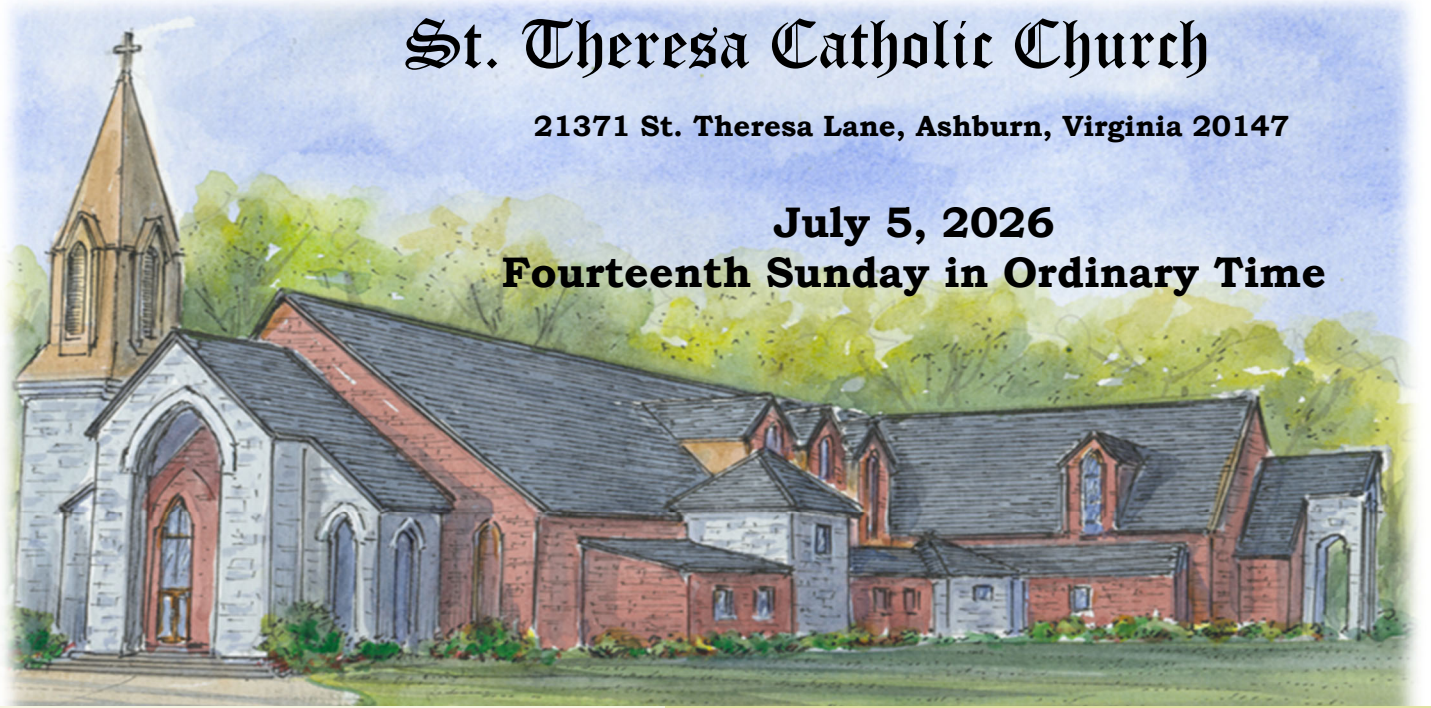

Our Stained Glass Windows, Part II

A few weeks back, I began to describe the stained-glass windows in the church. I mentioned that they retell the many ways God used angels in his work of drawing man back to himself, down through history. Let's pick up where we left off.

Starting now in the choir loft, we see a window that recalls the Gospel of Luke, this time, for a depiction of the Nativity, "Suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God" (Lk 2:13).

Continuing along the Mary side of the church, the next window is an image from the Gospel of Matthew, describing the dream in which an angel instructs St. Joseph to take the Christ child and his mother in flight to Egypt: "Behold, an angel appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, 'Rise, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt, and remain there till I tell you'" (Mt 2:13).

The following window is taken from the Gospel of Mark, describing the experience of Christ in the wilderness prior to starting his public ministry. "He was in the wilderness forty days, tempted by Satan; and he was with wild beasts; and the angels ministered to him" (Mk 1:13).

The next window is an image from the Gospel of John, depicting Christ's words to Nathaniel who declares him to be the very Son of God, "I say to you, you will see angels ascending and descending upon the Son of man" (Jn 1:51).

The next window returns again to the Gospel of Luke for a description of our Lord's Agony in the Garden, "There appeared to [our Lord] an angel from heaven, strengthening him" (Lk 22:43).

Over the south entrance we find a depiction of the resurrection according to the Gospel of Luke. "Two men stood by them in dazzling apparel; and as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them... 'He is not here, but has risen'" (Lk 24: 4-5).

The final window portrays the victory of St. Michael the Archangel over the devil, taken from the Book of Revelation. "Now war arose in heaven, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought but they were defeated and there was no longer any place for them in heaven" (Rev 12: 7-8).

There are many other smaller windows throughout the church which portray various images emblematic of the life of St. Theresa. In no particular order they are as follows: In the Carmelite order, each religious sister had a simple symbol—a sort of shorthand - which would identify her belongings. St. Theresa's symbol was a reed, and so is one of our small windows. St. Theresa's full religious name was "Sister Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face," and so we have a window which depicts Veronica's veil with the miraculous image of the face of Christ, and another window depicting the crib, or manger, of the infant Jesus. Since St. Theresa had a desire to be a missionary and a martyr, we have a window depicting a missionary's cross, and a martyr's palm. Since St. Theresa promised especially to pray for priests, we have a window depicting a priest's chalice.

The north stairwell contains two windows: one honors our military, and another honors St. Patrick. The south stairwell depicts the pelican feeding her young—an ancient Eucharistic symbol. By the confessionals, we see the image of a crowing rooster, reminding us of St. Peter's contrition for sin. By the Baptismal font, we see a window depicting the descent of the Holy Spirit, which is taken from the prayers of the Rite of Baptism.

A window in the vestry depicts images of a watch and lace. That's because the parents of St. Theresa, Saints Louis and Zelig Martin, were involved in the work of watch-making and the fabrication of Alençon lace. Finally in the sacristy, four windows depict the coats-of-arms of Pope John Paul II and Bishop John R. Keating (the pope and bishop at the time of the founding of the parish), as well as the coats-of-arms of Bishop Paul S. Loverde, and Pope Benedict XVI (the pope and bishop at the time of the dedication of the church, in 2009). All of the stained-glass windows in the church are the work of Lynchburg Stained-Glass in Lynchburg, Virginia.

I hope you found this to be informative, helpful, and interesting. Soon, I will continue with descriptions of other fixtures from our church interior.

How to Register to be a Parishioner of St. Theresa Catholic Church

In the sacramental life of the Church, Catholic faithful will need to prove residency in a parish. Registration with the parish office allows us to track your sacramental data and keep you connected with the life of the church.

In order to register, come to the parish office Monday – Friday 9:30am – 3:30pm (closed for lunch from 12-1) to fill out a registration card. Yellow registration cards can also be obtained at all of the Church entrances – these can be mailed to the parish or given to an usher during a church liturgy.

Status of Adult Children of Parishioners -- Upon reaching adulthood, children of registered parishioners must register again (if they reside within St. Theresa boundaries), separately and independently, as members of St. Theresa parish, even if they continue to live at home with their parents. These new registrations are valid until adult children move to another address. Upon moving elsewhere, they should register at the local parish in which they reside. Adult children of parishioners who no longer live within the parish will not be able to continue to claim parish membership.

Please contact the Parish Office to obtain a sponsor certificate prior to a Baptism or Confirmation.

Baptisms

Parents desiring Baptism for their child must attend a class (preferably before the child's birth) held the first Thursday of each month at **7pm** in a Conference Room in the Administration Bldg. You may schedule your child for the Sacrament of Baptism (held all Sundays 1:30pm) by visiting the Parish website under Faith, Sacraments, Baptism. Date is confirmed once all paperwork is received in the office (at least 2 weeks prior to the date of desired Baptism.)

Matrimony

The parish must be contacted at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date.

Before contacting the Parish Office, visit the Parish Website under Faith, Sacraments, Marriage. **You must be registered at least 3 months** prior to filling out the Marriage Preparation Questionnaire. A priest will contact you.

OCIA

Adults desiring instruction in the Catholic Faith should visit the website to register for OCIA classes.
