Review Sheet - Bible Passages

Bible passages are identified by book, chapter, and verse.

For example \rightarrow Ex 3:1-4

The name of the book comes first. It is often in abbreviated form. Your Bible's table of contents will help you determine what the abbreviation means. In our example, "Ex" stands for Exodus.

After the name of the book, there are two numbers. The first one identifies the chapter, which in our example is chapter three; it is followed by a colon.

The second number identifies the verse or verses, which in our example are verses one to four.
